On October 29, 2013, the Commission issued in this docket an *Order Adopting Policies Regarding Commission Internal Procedures (Order Adopting Policies)*, adopting certain internal Commission procedures.² Among the procedures adopted were those pertaining to “Transportation Economic Orders” and “Orders Assessing Costs for reimbursable dockets

pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1502.”³ Regarding the procedure for approving Transportation Economic Orders, the *Order Adopting Policies* begins a bullet-pointed list with a parenthetical reference to the “Standing minutes approving 24 order types signed and posted in the docket room” and on the Commission website.⁴ The procedure for approving Orders Assessing Costs also referenced the “Standing minutes” document.⁵ These procedures allow Transportation Economic Orders and Orders Assessing Costs to be “generated” separately from a Commission business meeting.⁶

3. On November 7, 2013, the Commission issued an *Amended Order Adopting Policies Regarding Commission Procedures*. Substantively, the *Amended Order* differed from the *Order Adopting Policies* by adding the provision that “[t]he attached proposed internal procedures are subject to modification following the receipt of public input and comments on those procedures.”⁷ Attachment A, Sections G and H, adopted by the *Amended Order* are identical to Attachment A, Sections G and H, adopted by the *Order Adopting Policies*.⁸ The *Amended Order* also nullified and replaced the *Order Adopting Policies*.⁹

4. The Commission finds that the above procedures for the approval of Transportation Economic Orders and Orders Assessing Costs no longer serve the function contemplated by the *Amended Order*. Therefore, the Commission finds such procedures shall be discontinued and superseded by the procedures set forth in this Order below.

5. The Commission finds that Transportation Economic Orders and Orders Assessing Costs will be considered for approval as part of the Commission’s consent agenda at Commission business meetings.

6. Regarding Transportation Economic Orders, the Commission will take action on eleven (11) individual types of Economic Orders under a single docket number.¹⁰ The individual Orders being considered for approval will be listed on a report that will appear as a portion of the consent agenda.¹¹ The report will create a record of Commission action and be reflected in the minutes of each respective business meeting where action was taken. Each individual order issued shall be accessible to the public for viewing on the Commission's webpage under the single docket number. The Commission will take action on any Transportation Economic Orders other than the eleven (11) types mentioned above as individually docketed consent agenda items, just as it does with other consent agenda items.

7. Transportation Division Staff shall conduct a biannual review of the templates being used for the eleven (11) individual types of Economic Orders to ensure accuracy.

8. Regarding Orders Assessing Costs, the Commission will take action on these as individually docketed consent agenda items, just as it does with other consent agenda items.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The procedures set forth in paragraphs 5 through 8 of this Order are adopted.

B. The procedures set forth in Attachment A, Sections G and H of the Commission's *Order Adopting Policies Regarding Commission Procedures* and *Amended Order Adopting Policies Regarding Commission Procedures*, are discontinued and superseded by the procedures set forth in this Order.


C. The parties have fifteen (15) days from the date this Order was served by electronic mail in which to petition for reconsideration.¹²
