ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

- 1. On September 18, 2018, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* against Gateway Resources U.S.A., Inc. (Operator), concluding the Operator committed three violations of K.A.R. 82-3-111 because the subject wells have been inactive in excess of the time allowed by regulation without being plugged, returned to service, or approved for temporary abandonment (TA) status.¹
 - On October 18, 2018, the Operator filed a letter requesting a hearing.² 2.
- 3. On December 10, 2018, a letter dated December 6, 2018 was filed by the Operator's President, Blaine Hanks, stating: "I hereby withdraw my request for a hearing to appeal the assessment as Gateway Resources USA Inc. has satisfied its compliance obligations on the White G-3, Carol R Knisley 33-1, and is nearly complete with its obligations on the White G-5."
- 4. Based on the Operator's withdrawal letter, the Commission finds further proceedings are unnecessary. Thus, no hearing should be held, and the docket should be closed.
