Pursuant to the 34.5kV formula based ratemaking (“FBR”) protocols approved by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) for Prairie Land Electric Cooperative, Inc. (“Prairie Land) in Docket No. 21-SEPE-049-TAR (“21-049 Docket”) (the “Prairie Land 34.5kV FBR Protocols”), “Entities granted intervention in 21-SEPE-049-TAR who either are or represent customers of of Prairie Land at the time of the Annual Update filing will be considered automatically approved for intervention upon the filing of an Entry of Appearance in any individual Annual Update filing, provided they are not prohibited from participation by statute or otherwise.”¹

The application filed by Prairie Land in this matter is one of the annual 34.5kV FBR application contemplated under the 21-049 Docket Agreement. KPP was a signatory to the 21-049 Docket Agreement, is not otherwise prohibited by law from participating in this proceeding and thus, is considered an intervenor upon the filing of the instate Entry of Appearance in lieu of
