SUSPENSION ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined the files and record, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On May 9, 2018, Craw-Kan Telephone Association, Inc. (Craw-Kan) filed an Application requesting Commission approval of tariff changes to its Local Exchange Tariff, Part 2, Sheet 34. Supplementing its Application, Craw-Kan included a copy of its proposed Tariff Sheet reducing the company's monthly price for ISDN PRI. The Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to K.S.A. 66-104 and K.S.A. 66-117.
2. The Commission Staff (Staff) has determined that it needs more than 30 days to fully review Craw-Kan's Application and suspension is required to allow sufficient time for Staff's review and investigation of this matter. Although Staff reserves the full 240 days, Staff recognizes the need for efficient use of Commission resources and time and will thus strive to complete its Report and Recommendation by July 31, 2018.
3. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of the Application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. The Application should be suspended for a period of 240 days from the date the Application was filed, May 9, 2018, until January 4, 2019, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c).

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) The Commission issues a Suspension Order as provided herein.

(B) Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹

(C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
