ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the files and records, and being duly advised, the Commission finds:

1. On May 15, 2015, Stephen and Karen Gradwohl filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L).
2. KCP&L filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss on June 11, 2015, with an errata being filed on June 12, 2015 containing an attachment omitted from the June 11, 2015 filing.
3. Staff filed its Report and Recommendation (R&R) on September 28, 2015.
4. On October 7, 2015, KCP&L filed a Motion for Extension of Time in which to respond to Staff's R&R, and by Order dated October 13, 2015, the Commission granted the extension of time requested until November 9, 2015.
5. The Commission designates Samuel Feather, Deputy General Counsel, 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, KS 66604-4027, telephone number (785) 271-3186, s.feather@kcc.ks.gov, to serve as Prehearing Officer in this proceeding.¹ The Prehearing Officer may conduct any prehearing conferences necessary to address any matters appropriately

considered in a prehearing conference, including all items listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b) of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). The Commission may designate other staff members to serve in this capacity.


THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:
