**MOTION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE**

Olathe Public Schools USD 233, Blue Valley Schools USD 229, Spring Hill School District USD 230, and Johnson County Community College (collectively, the "Schools") respectfully file this Motion for Administrative Notice<sup>1</sup> in the above-referenced case. In support of this Motion, the Schools state to the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("KCC" or "Commission") as follows:

1. On February 1, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed an Application requesting authorization to make certain changes to its charges for retail electric service in Kansas.

2. On October 24, 2018, the Commission convened an Evidentiary Hearing where it received "pre-filed" testimony, including testimony in support of a Unanimous Settlement Agreement adopted and recommended by the parties in this proceeding. The Commission also examined certain witnesses regarding the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

3. During such examination, Commissioners asked questions regarding the potential investigation of a KCP&L Schools tariff, as contemplated in the Settlement Agreement. Several questions focused on the definition of a "school" and what entities such a tariff should apply to.

4. The Schools agree with Dr. Robert Glass's testimony that this question is best

addressed during the investigation. However, certain questions directly asked about the applicability of existing School tariffs to various types of entities. Because these Commission-approved tariffs exist in the KCC's files and records and may provide information directly responsive to the Commissioners' inquiries, the Schools submit it is in the public interest to admit such tariffs into the record for the Commissioners' review and consideration.<sup>2</sup>

5. Attached hereto as Attachments A-I are the following tariffs applicable<sup>3</sup> to Kansas Schools:

6. The above list of tariffs is the product of the Schools' preliminary research of only the largest KCC-jurisdictional utilities' tariffs.<sup>4</sup> It is not a comprehensive list of School tariffs available to educational institutions throughout the State.

7. These School tariffs, as a whole, apply to a wide variety of educational institutions, including both public and private entities (typically not "for-profit" private entities). Most apply to primary and secondary educational institutions, and some apply to colleges and universities. The Commission may also note some tariffs are applicable to religious and charitable organizations, as identified during Commissioner questioning.

8. As noted above, the Schools agree with Staff's testimony that the Commission need not define the applicability of a yet-to-be formulated Schools tariff in this case. The Schools agree such a question will be relevant to the general investigation contemplated in the Settlement Agreement.

WHEREFORE, the Schools respectfully request the Commission take administrative notice of the above-referenced tariffs pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-230(h) or, in the alternative, admit the tariffs as late-filed exhibits pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-230(g).

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<sup>4</sup> It is the Schools' understanding that Midwest Energy's tariffs are no longer jurisdictional to the KCC. However, it appears Midwest Energy still offers a Schools tariff previously approved by the KCC.
