Section 3: W/Z/VW/4 Meril proposes to unilize the oil rights to a pool within the Chester formation beneath the area of the Unit. The stratigraphic equivalent of the Chester formation is shown on the logs for the River Bend #6 well (API No. 15-055-22505) to exist between the measured depths of 4,798' (-1,946' subsea TVD) and 4,835' (-1,983' subsea TVD).
