### **ORDER CLOSING DOCKET**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On May 12, 2017, Globe Operating, Inc., (Operator) filed an Application for an exception to the requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) with regard to the DeWerff #1 well in Stafford County, Kansas.
- 2. On July 11, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Designate a Prehearing Officer and Schedule a Prehearing Conference.
- 3. On August 3, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference for August 24, 2017.<sup>1</sup>
- 4. On August 9, 2017, Staff filed a Motion to Close Docket, stating that the Operator confirmed the pit at issue was closed on August 8, 2017, and the Operator no longer desired a

hearing.<sup>2</sup> Exhibit B of Staff's Motion contained a Commission "Closure of Surface Pit" form, indicating pit closure.

5. Based on Staff's Motion and the Operator's documentation that its surface pit was closed on August 8, 2017, the Commission finds an exception to the pit closure time limitations pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-602(a)(2) is not warranted and the docket should be closed.

## THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. The docket is closed.
- B. Parties have 15 days, plus three days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.<sup>3</sup>
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
