RURAL TELEPHONE SERVICE COMPANY, INC. DBA NEX-TECH'S MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO FILE ITS RESPONSE

COMES NOW Rural Telephone Service Company, Inc. d/b/a Nex-Tech ("Nex-Tech"), pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-217(b), K.A.R. 82-1-218(d), and K.A.R. 82-1-220(c), and submits its motion for enlargement of the time in which Nex-Tech is allowed to file a written response to the formal Complaint filed with the Commission. In support of its motion, Nex-Tech shows the Commission as follows:

- 1. On January 18, 2019, Complainant Ideatek Telecom, LLC ("Ideatek") commenced the above captioned proceeding by filing a formal Complaint against Nex-Tech requesting expedited treatment with the Commission.
- 2. On January 18, 2019, Respondent Nex-Tech was served with a copy of the Complaint via electronic mail.
- 3. On January 22, 2019, Respondent Nex-Tech filed its Initial Response to the Complaint.
- 4. On January 29, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Assessing Costs to both parties.

- On January 30, 2019, Ideatek filed a Correction to Complaint and Amended
 Complaint and Request for Expedited Review and Request for Interim Ruling.
- 6. On January 31, 2019, The Commission issued an Order Appointing Examiner Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-220a(f) designating Walker Hendrix as the examiner in this Docket.
- 7. On February 1, 2019, the Examiner Order on Request for Expedited Review and Other Procedural Rulings was issued denying expedited review and setting a scheduling conference for February 13, 2019.
- 8. On February 4, 2019, Verification on Complaint and Amended Complaint was filed on behalf of Ideatek.
- 9. Nex-Tech is uncertain of the required due date for filing its response. The uncertainty is due to the fact that the original Complaint sought expedited treatment, Ideatek filed an Amended Complaint which still sought expedited treatment, and two days later, the examiner issued an Order denying expedited treatment and setting a scheduling conference to be held on February 13, 2019. In using best efforts to calculate the due date, Nex-Tech believes its response would be due on February 11, 2019.
- 10. Due to scheduling conflicts and unavailability of key Nex-Tech personnel and counsel involved and to clear up the confusion regarding calculating the required due date for response, Nex-Tech respectfully requests an enlargement of time in which Nex-Tech is to file its written response to Complainant's Amended Complaint up to and including Friday, February 15, 2019.

- 11. Nex-Tech's request for an enlargement of time is timely made; it is made in good faith and Nex-Tech believes it has demonstrated good cause in support of its request.

 Complainant will not be prejudiced by the granting of Nex-Tech's request.
- 12. The undersigned counsel for Nex-Tech has discussed this request for extension with both counsel for the Complainant and Commission Staff. Counsel expressed that neither Complainant nor Staff have objection to the instant Motion.

WHEREFORE, Nex-Tech respectfully requests an Order of the Commission granting Nex-Tech's Motion for an Enlargement of Time in which to file a written response to the Amended Complaint of Ideatek up to and including Friday, February 15, 2019.
