ORDER APPROVING TARIFF REVISIONS

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, the Commission finds and concludes:

1. On May 7, 2025, Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy”), filed with the Commission an application requesting approval of its Schedule III – Schedule of Customer Advances for Construction of Mains and Company Service Lines, along with a spreadsheet detailing the “Kansas Embedded Cost Analysis” that reflects the account balances from its Annual Form 2 filing for 2024.¹

2. The Commission has full power, authority, and jurisdiction to control Atmos as a natural gas public utility pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,201. The Commission holds jurisdiction over Atmos’ rates and terms of service under K.S.A. 66-1,202. All tariff revisions requested by Atmos pertaining to jurisdictional services must be approved by the Commission pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117.

3. Commission staff (“Staff”) reviewed Atmos’ application and filed its Report and Recommendation in the docket on May 21, 2025. CURB has had the opportunity to review Staff’s findings and has no objection to the recommendations, nor has any other party to the docket objected to Staff’s findings.

4. Specifically, Staff reviewed Atmos Energy’s Kansas Embedded Cost Analysis in order to confirm that the plant account balances, and the number of customers used in the AEC calculations matched the data reported in Atmos Energy’s 2024 – Atmos Energy – Supplemental Annual Report.” Staff verified the data supplied in Atmos Energy’s 2025 application matches Atmos Energy’s “2024 – Atmos Energy – Supplemental Report” and determined that the updated AEC calculations for both the mains and services are correct.²

5. The Commission adopts Staff’s analysis, findings, and recommendations as stated in its Report and Recommendation dated May 19, 2025, which are incorporated by reference herein.

6. The Commission concludes Atmos Energy’s proposed changes with the revision adding account 380 to page two of the tariff Schedule III are reasonable.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Atmos Energy’s application and revised tariff, filed on May 7, 2025, is hereby approved contingent upon Atmos Energy correcting page 2 of the tariff (Schedule III) to include account 380 in Section B.

B. Atmos Energy is directed to timely revise page two of the tariff to include account 380.

C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).³

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purposes of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
