## ORDER

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On October 20, 2005, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Kansas (SWBT) filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement (Agreement) between SWBT and DSLnet Communications, LLC (DSLnet). The Agreement was executed on September 28, 2005.
- 2. Based on a Memorandum of Understanding signed by SWBT and DSLnet and filed with the Commission on December 17, 2004 in Docket No. 05-SWBT-368-ARB, DSLnet is deemed to have adopted the Prairie Stream Communications, Inc. interconnection agreement previously approved by the Commission in Docket No. 06-SWBT-235-IAT that was the result of arbitrated proceedings designed to develop successor agreements to the Kansas 271 agreement. Upon Commission approval, the Agreement will supersede the interconnection agreement between SWBT and DSLnet approved by the Commission in Docket No. 01-SWBT-399-IAT.

- 3. There are no outstanding issues between the parties that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration. DSLnet is properly registered with the office of the Kansas Secretary of State and is currently listed as "active and in good standing" with that office.
- 4. SWBT files the Agreement seeking Commission approval of its terms and conditions consistent with the Telecommunications Act of 1996. SWBT believes approval of the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity, and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.
- 5. SWBT specifically requests that the Commission refrain from taking any action to change, suspend, or otherwise delay implementation of this agreement, in keeping with the support of competition previously demonstrated by the Commission.
- 6. The Commission finds and concludes that the Agreement between SWBT and DSLnet should be approved. The implementation of the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not, on its face, discriminate against any telecommunications provider not a party to the agreement.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. The application of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. for approval of an Interconnection Agreement with DSLnet Communications, LLC, is hereby approved.
- B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
