PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Prehearing Officer sets the following procedural schedule, for the following reasons:

- 1. On June 5, 2014, a prehearing conference was held on this matter. The following parties were present at the prehearing conference: Altavista Energy, represented by Stanford J. Smith, Jr.; Commission Staff, represented by Jonathan R. Myers; and protestant Ralph Tomlinson. At the beginning of the prehearing conference, it was noted that there were additional parties that had signed the April 25, 2014, letter protesting this matter, who had not been notified of the prehearing conference.¹
- 2. At this point, the Prehearing Officer left the room so that the parties present could freely discuss Altavista's application. Upon the Prehearing Officer's return, the parties that were present recommended the following schedule in this matter:

¹ It appears that the April 25, 2014, protest letter was submitted in the form of a petition, mailed to the Commission by Mr. Tomlinson. The petition was signed by: Virgil Allen; Barbara & Ralph Tomlinson; Roma & Ralph Earles; and Franklin W. Turley. No addresses were included on the petition. On May 2, 2014, Staff sent a letter to Mr. Tomlinson, requesting confirmation that a hearing was requested. On May 12, 2014, Mr. Tomlinson sent a letter of confirmation, but without the names of the other individuals. However, there appears to be no dispute that the following individuals request a hearing: Virgil Allen, Barbara & Ralph Tomlinson, and Roma & Ralph Earles.

- 3. After recommending a schedule, the parties present at the prehearing conference agreed that Staff's attorney, Mr. Myers, would call the protestants that had not been notified of the prehearing conference, to confirm that the recommended schedule worked for the other protestants. The parties present at the prehearing conference further agreed that Mr. Myers could then contact the Prehearing Officer, to inform him whether the recommended schedule worked for all parties. The prehearing conference was then adjourned.
- 4. On June 6, 2014, Mr. Myers emailed the Prehearing Officer, informing him that the recommended schedule appears to work for all parties.³

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. The schedule set forth above is hereby adopted. The parties did not suggest a time of day for the status conference. Therefore, the July 11, 2014, status conference is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. The status conference will be by telephone, and is anticipated to take approximately fifteen minutes. Parties must call the Prehearing Officer at 316-337-6200 for the dial-in number. Any party not attending the status conference may be held in default by the Commission.
