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1       **I.       INTRODUCTION**

2           **Q.       Please state your name, business address, and present position.**

3           A.       My name is Emily Hyland. I am the Resources Strategic Communications Director  
4 with HDR Engineering, Inc. (“HDR”). My business address is 1601 Utica Avenue South, Suite  
5 600, St. Louis Park, Minnesota 55416-3400.

6           **Q.       Please describe your educational and professional background.**

7           A.       A summary of my educational background and professional experience is attached  
8 as an Exhibit to my testimony.

9           **Q.       Please describe HDR and its role in the AC Collector Line routing process.**

10          A.       HDR is an employee-owned firm founded in 1917 that provides engineering,  
11 architecture, and environmental consulting services. HDR has provided engineering and  
12 environmental services on over 50,000 miles of transmission lines nationwide. We have permitted  
13 and provided routing, strategic communications and environmental compliance monitoring  
14 support for thousands of miles of 115kV and above transmission line projects. Grain Belt Express  
15 LLC (“Grain Belt Express”) retained HDR as a consultant to support the public outreach activities  
16 that were integrated into the route selection process for the AC Collector Lines. HDR personnel  
17 were part of a team that included personnel from Burns & McDonnell, and Invenergy LLC who  
18 collaborated on the routing process for the AC Collector Lines (“Routing Team”).

19          **Q.       What is the purpose of your testimony?**

20          A.       The purpose of my testimony is to support Grain Belt Express’ Application  
21 requesting that the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) issue a  
22 siting permit establishing the route for two inter-related transmission lines and associated facilities  
23 (1) a double-circuit 345 kV transmission line of approximately 46 miles in length across portions  
24 of Gray, Meade, and Ford Counties (the “Meade-Dodge City Line”); and (2) a single or double-

1 circuit 345 kV transmission line of approximately 16 miles in length traversing a portion of Ford  
2 County (the “Bucklin-Dodge City Line”). Together, Grain Belt Express may refer to these lines  
3 as the “AC Collector Lines”, which make up a portion of the AC Collector System. My testimony  
4 provides an overview of the public outreach associated with the routing process for the AC  
5 Collector Lines.

6 **Q. Are you sponsoring any exhibits as a part of your testimony?**

7 A. Yes, I am sponsoring the following exhibits:

12 **II. PUBLIC OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT**

13 **Q. Please summarize the public outreach that Grain Belt Express undertook as**  
14 **part of the routing process for the AC Collector Lines.**

15 A. The public outreach process included several opportunities for public input,  
16 including a series of in-person public open houses, a virtual public open house, and direct  
17 landowner communication. The public outreach process started the first week of February 2024  
18 with the mailing of the open house invitation postcard. Postcards arrived in mailboxes the week of  
19 February 8, 2024. A project website, [KansasACCollector.com](http://KansasACCollector.com), and a project email address,  
20 [Connect@kansasaccollector.com](mailto:Connect@kansasaccollector.com), were created for landowners to learn about the project and  
21 contact the Routing Team ahead of the open houses. These tools went live the week of February  
22 8, 2024 and remained open for routing input and participation through March 15, 2024. Following  
23 the Application filing, information about the public hearings and next steps regarding the AC  
24 Collector Lines will be available. Two English newspaper advertisements were placed in three  
25 newspapers, the Dodge City Globe (Ford County newspaper of record), Meade County News

1 (Meade County newspaper of record) and the Jacksonian Newspaper (Gray County newspaper of  
2 record) the weeks of February 12 and 19, 2024. Two additional Spanish newspaper ads ran in the  
3 Dodge City Globe and one in its Spanish paper, Del Suroeste during the same time period. In-  
4 person public open houses were held on February 27, 28 and 29, 2024 in Ford, Meade and Gray  
5 Counties, respectively. A virtual open house was hosted on the project website from February 23  
6 to March 15, 2024. Further details about the in-person and virtual open houses are provided below.

7 **Q. How were stakeholders identified prior to the open houses?**

8 A. After the potential routes for the AC Collector Lines were developed, the Burns &  
9 McDonnell routing team created notification boundaries to identify potentially affected parcels  
10 and landowners. This boundary was established 1,000 feet from all alternate route centerlines of  
11 the Alternate Route Networks through Gray, Meade, and Ford Counties for both AC Collector  
12 Lines. This list of landowners was used to provide notification of the public open houses,  
13 discussed below. The Alternate Route Networks are described in detail in the Direct Testimony of  
14 Jamie Precht.

15 **Q. How is Grain Belt Express providing notice of the current Application?**

16 A. Exhibits EH-3 and EH-4 includes all parcels and corresponding landowners within  
17 1,000 feet of the centerline of the Bucklin Line Proposed Route and Meade Line Propose Route.  
18 Grain Belt Express will mail a cover letter and copy of the Application to each landowner listed in  
19 Exhibits EH-3 and EH-4. This exceeds the filing requirement set forth at K.S.A. 66-1,178(a)(2).  
20 Data for inclusion in Exhibits EH-3 and EH-4 was sourced less than 75 days prior to the filing  
21 date. The procedural schedule proposed by Grain Belt Express, as filed simultaneously with this  
22 Application, includes a July 9, 2024 deadline to submit an affidavit addressing notice for the

1 forthcoming local public hearings. That affidavit will include copies of the landowner notice letter  
2 and newspaper advertisements for the local public hearings.

3 **Q. What contact did Grain Belt Express have with elected officials in the AC**  
4 **Collector Line areas?**

5 A. Grain Belt Express contacted the Commissioners in Gray, Meade and Ford  
6 Counties and provided information about the AC Collector Lines through several different  
7 channels. Members of the Routing Team also engaged with elected officials who represent  
8 relevant legislative districts. Information about the AC Collector Lines and the planned open  
9 houses was made available to the elected officials. At the open houses, local officials who came  
10 were provided packets that included print out copies of the meeting's display boards. Those who  
11 couldn't attend the open houses were provided the information electronically or by hand delivery.  
12 Kevin Chandler's Direct Testimony provides more detailed information on Grain Belt Express'  
13 engagement with elected officials.<sup>1</sup>

14 **Q. What were the objectives of the public outreach process?**

15 A. There are several objectives we try to achieve through public outreach:  
16 • To communicate the purpose and need for the AC Collector Lines and to seek  
17 feedback on the Alternate Route Networks from government officials, non-  
18 governmental organizations, landowners and the public.  
19 • To convey Grain Belt Express' respect for private property rights and to provide  
20 information about planned construction practices and planned efforts to minimize  
21 any agricultural impacts of construction of the AC Collector Lines.

- 1 • To provide general information about the right-of-way acquisition process and
- 2 landowner compensation.
- 3 • To develop the AC Collector Lines in a collaborative, methodical and transparent
- 4 manner.

5 As with the rest of the AC Collector Lines development, we operate on the premise that an  
 6 extensive, methodical, multi-level public outreach strategy is the best way to determine a proposed  
 7 routes for the AC Collector Lines. An extensive public outreach process can also support the  
 8 acquisition of necessary transmission line easements through voluntary transactions, as discussed  
 9 further by Grain Belt Express Witness Brad Fine.

10 **Q. Describe the level of outreach and public communication involved with respect**  
 11 **to the development of the AC Collector Lines.**

12 A. The public outreach process for the AC Collector Lines included the following:

- 13 • A standalone project page [KansasACCollector.com](http://KansasACCollector.com).
- 14 • A dedicated email address [Connect@KansasACCollector.com](mailto:Connect@KansasACCollector.com). This email was
- 15 used during the initial public outreach and will continue to be used to share
- 16 information and collect comments or questions through construction.
- 17 • Placement of nine newspaper ads in four papers in the three counties:

19 **Q. Did the Routing Team respond to comments received during the routing process?**

1           A.     The Routing Team responded to those who indicated they would like a personal  
2 response from the Routing Team on their comment card. Responses were also given to questions  
3 received through the virtual open house and the email address.

4           **Q.     What information is available on the AC Collector Lines website?**

5           A.     The virtual open house was accessible from February 23 to March 15, 2024 on the  
6 AC Collector Lines website. The information presented on the virtual open house was identical to  
7 the exhibits at the in-person open houses. This included information on: AC Collector Line Need  
8 and Location, About Invenergy, AC Collector Line Benefits, Timeline, Routing Process,  
9 Structures, Vendor Suppliers and Input Opportunities.

10           In addition to project information, there was a comment form and an interactive comment  
11 map showing the Alternate Route Networks that allowed participants to zoom into specific  
12 locations to provide GIS specific comments. Screenshots from the virtual website are included in  
13 Exhibit EH-2.

14           **Q.     What communications has Grain Belt Express received through these various**  
15 **channels?**

16           A.     The project team received the following communications both digitally and in-  
17 person. A total of 51 digital comments were received through online comment form submissions,  
18 23 interactive map submissions and 8 email comments, as of May 29, 2024. A total of 27 in-person  
19 comments were received including 25 completed routing questionnaires and two completed vendor  
20 supplier interest forms.

21           **Q.     How did Grain Belt Express invite participation in the open houses?**

22           A.     Postcards were mailed directly to landowners located within 1000 feet of the  
23 centerlines of the AC Collector Lines Alternate Route Networks in Ford, Meade and Gray



1 Counties. The postcards included information for each of the six meetings, general project  
2 information, and how landowners can leave comments for the project team. A total of 500  
3 notification postcards were mailed: 145 landowners were on the Bucklin-Dodge City line, 348  
4 were on the Meade-Dodge City line, and 7 were on both the Bucklin-Dodge City line and the  
5 Meade-Dodge City line. A copy of the postcard can be found in Exhibit EH-2.

6 In addition to direct mailed postcards, a public notice ran twice in Ford, Meade and Gray  
7 Counties in advance of the open houses (run dates February 14 – February 22, 2024). Each  
8 newspaper notice was a full-page advertisement. In the Dodge City Daily Globe, Grain Belt  
9 Express ran an English and Spanish advertisement along with two additional advertisements in  
10 their Spanish version of the newspaper. The Spanish version of the newspaper was only able to  
11 run the public open house advertisements once (February 14, 2024). Following the open houses,  
12 additional newspaper advertisements thanking participants and reminder the public of the virtual  
13 open house ran on March 13 and 14, 2024. A complete list of newspapers, advertisement run dates  
14 and the advertisements can be found in Exhibit EH-2.

15 **Q. Please explain how Grain Belt Express conducted the open house meetings.**

16 A. Grain Belt Express offered two in-person two-hour public open house meeting  
17 options per County per day (11:00 AM – 1:00 PM and 4:00 – 6:00 PM). Each open house followed  
18 the same format and had the same information and mapping materials available. When people  
19 arrived, they were asked to sign-in at the registration table to verify contact information and  
20 identify the AC Collector Lines of interest. A routing questionnaire and general overview handout  
21 was provided to each attendee for the AC Collector Line of interest. The open houses included a  
22 series of information boards to learn more about the project, a set of aerial table maps to review  
23 the Alternate Route Networks and computer stations to collect information on the segment options

1 within the Alternate Route Networks from attendees. Attendees were encouraged to complete their  
2 routing questionnaire to help identify issues related to the Alternate Route Networks.

3 **Q. What information about the AC Collector Lines was presented at these open**  
4 **houses?**

5 A. At the sign-in table, two general overview handouts were available – one for each  
6 of the AC Collector Lines – in English and Spanish was provided to each attendee. A routing  
7 questionnaire was provided to each attendee. A series of information boards were available for  
8 attendees to review and learn more about the project. The information boards included 1)  
9 Welcome, 2) Bringing power to where it’s needed most, 3) About AC Collector System, 4)  
10 Alternative Route Network, 5) Project benefits, 6) Bucklin-Dodge City Line overview, 7) Bucklin-  
11 Dodge City Line map, 8) Meade-Dodge City Line overview, 9) Meade-Dodge City Line map, 10)  
12 Anticipated timeline, 11) Routing process, 12) Anticipated structures – single circuit, 13)  
13 Anticipated structures – double circuit, 14) Information for local construction suppliers and  
14 vendors, 15) We value your input. A set of large aerial table maps showed detailed imagery of the  
15 segment options within the Alternate Route Networks. A vendor supplier form was available for  
16 interested vendors to complete. The materials can be found in Exhibit EH-2.

17 **Q. What level of participation did Grain Belt Express see during the open houses?**

18 A. A total of 140 people participated in the six open houses. On Tuesday, February  
19 27, 2024, the Ford County meeting had a total of 80 attendees including 55 at the midday meeting  
20 (11 AM – 1 PM) and 25 at the evening meeting (4 – 6 PM). On Wednesday, February 28, 2024,  
21 the Meade County meeting had a total of 34 attendees including 20 at the midday meeting (11 AM  
22 – 1 PM) and 14 at the evening meeting (4 – 6 PM). On Thursday, February 29, 2024, the Gray  
23 County meeting had a total of 26 attendees including 17 at the midday meeting (11 AM – 1 PM)

1 and 9 at the evening meeting (4 – 6 PM). A total of 25 routing questionnaires were received with  
2 17 at the Ford County open houses, five at the Meade County open houses and three at the Gray  
3 County open houses.

4 **Q. Did Grain Belt Express provide other opportunities for public outreach?**

5 A. For those unable to participate in one of the six public open houses and to increase  
6 access to the open house meeting materials, Grain Belt Express hosted a virtual open house  
7 February 23 – March 15, 2024, to allow visitors to review the same materials presented at the open  
8 house. The virtual open house was hosted on the project website at [www.KansasACCollector.com](http://www.KansasACCollector.com).  
9 The virtual open house had a total of 289 unique visitors. The virtual open house received 20  
10 comment form submissions and 23 map comments. Screen captures of the virtual open house can  
11 be found in Exhibit EH-2.

12 **Q. Has Grain Belt Express undertaken any additional public outreach since the**  
13 **open houses were conducted?**

14 A. Following the open houses, additional newspaper ads were published in each of the  
15 papers of record reminding participants of the virtual open house and to encourage them to provide  
16 their comments to the Routing Team. The ads were published on the following dates in these  
17 newspapers:

18 The virtual open house remained open for two weeks following the in-person open houses. The  
19 email address remains active if stakeholders want to reach out following the open houses.  
20 Questions received through the email address receive a response from the Routing Team including  
21 after the open houses and virtual open house comment window closed.

1           **Q.    How has Grain Belt Express used the information that landowners have**  
2 **provided through these forms of outreach?**

3           A.    Questionnaires received during the public open houses along with public comment  
4 forms and map comments received during the virtual open house were provided to the Routing  
5 Team for their review and consideration as part of the routing process. Additional comments  
6 received through the project email address were also forwarded to the Routing Team for their  
7 review and consideration. This information was used to modify the Alternate Route Networks,  
8 resulting in the Refined Alternate Route Networks. Further discussion of how public comment  
9 impacted the development of the Refined Alternate Route Networks and selection of the Proposed  
10 Routes can be found in the Direct Testimony and Exhibits of Jamie Precht.

11           **III.   CONCLUSION**

12           **Q.    Does this conclude your testimony?**

13           A.    Yes, it does.

### **Hyland Curriculum Vitae**

I have a Bachelor of Arts degree in Environmental Studies from Gustavus Adolphus College and a Master of Arts in Strategic Communication Management from Concordia in St Paul. I have been employed by HDR since July 2006. My initial role at HDR was an Environmental Scientist working on routing and siting on transmission lines. My current title is the Resources Strategic Communications Director. I assist with the strategy for stakeholder outreach for pursuits and projects with clients in the power, waste and industrial markets. At HDR, the majority of my project work has been power generation and energy delivery projects. During my career I have been involved in providing siting and permitting analysis and developing and executing public engagement efforts for over 1,500 miles of electric transmission lines, primarily in the Midwest.

In my current position as Resources Strategic Communications Director, I am responsible for managing projects that involve stakeholder outreach for electric transmission lines as well as linear transportation and wastewater projects. I have performed routing studies, performed agency consultation, managed public outreach, and assisted with obtaining the necessary permits for other projects in the Midwest.

I have been the Public Outreach Manager for various Ameren Transmission Projects including Spoon River Transmission Project, Adams County Connector, Faraday PPG Connector, and LaSalle County Connector. I also provided testimony support for each of these filing for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the Illinois Commerce Commission.

I have also designed and executed an eight-year outreach program for the Great Northern Transmission Line, 240-mile 500 kV transmission line from the Canadian-Minnesota Border to the Minnesota Iron Range. An upfront collaborative stakeholder outreach effort allowed routing and siting input from all stakeholders within the Study Area through the Certificate of Need and

Route Permit Application process with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (PUC) and the Federal Presidential Permit process with the United States Department of Energy (DOE). I continued to lead the outreach program through construction (completed in June 2020). I also worked on two 345 kV transmission line projects, Brookings County to Hampton CapX2020 line (South Dakota and Minnesota) and the Center to Grand Forks (North Dakota) line, and both received state approval and are through the majority of construction. I served as the Public Outreach Manager and support the Project Manager for an approximately 160-mile 345 kV Big Stone South to Ellendale Transmission Line (North Dakota and South Dakota). The Big Stone South to Ellendale Project received route approvals and permits from South Dakota Public Utilities Commission and North Dakota Public Service Commission in 2014 and I continued to support the project through construction (completed in 2019).

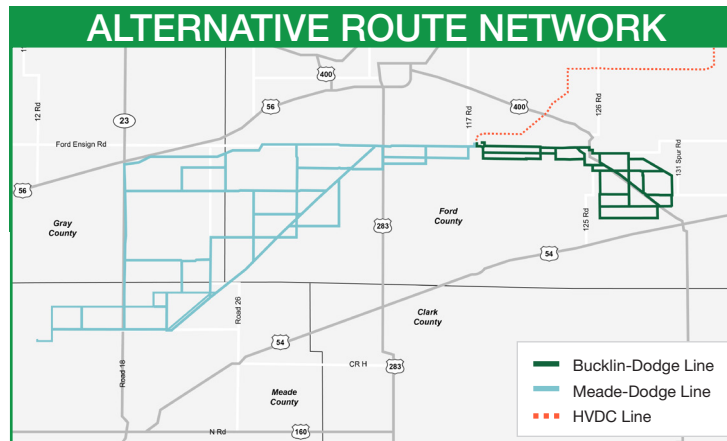

The location for new electric utility infrastructure (the Alternating Current Collector System, or “AC Collector System”) is currently being studied in Southwest Kansas. By providing nearby wind and solar facilities with a path to new markets via the Grain Belt Express high voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission line, the AC Collector System will **enable economic and reliability benefits** for Southwest Kansas families and communities, while **creating new jobs** and **investment in local economies**.

Prior to filing a siting application with the Kansas Corporation Commission, Grain Belt Express LLC, owner of the Grain Belt Express HVDC transmission line and a subsidiary of American-led energy company Invenergy, is seeking public feedback on the alternative route network being considered for the AC Collector System. The project study area, where the alternative route network is located, includes parts of Ford, Meade, and Gray Counties.

The AC Collector System consists of overhead AC electric transmission lines and associated infrastructure. 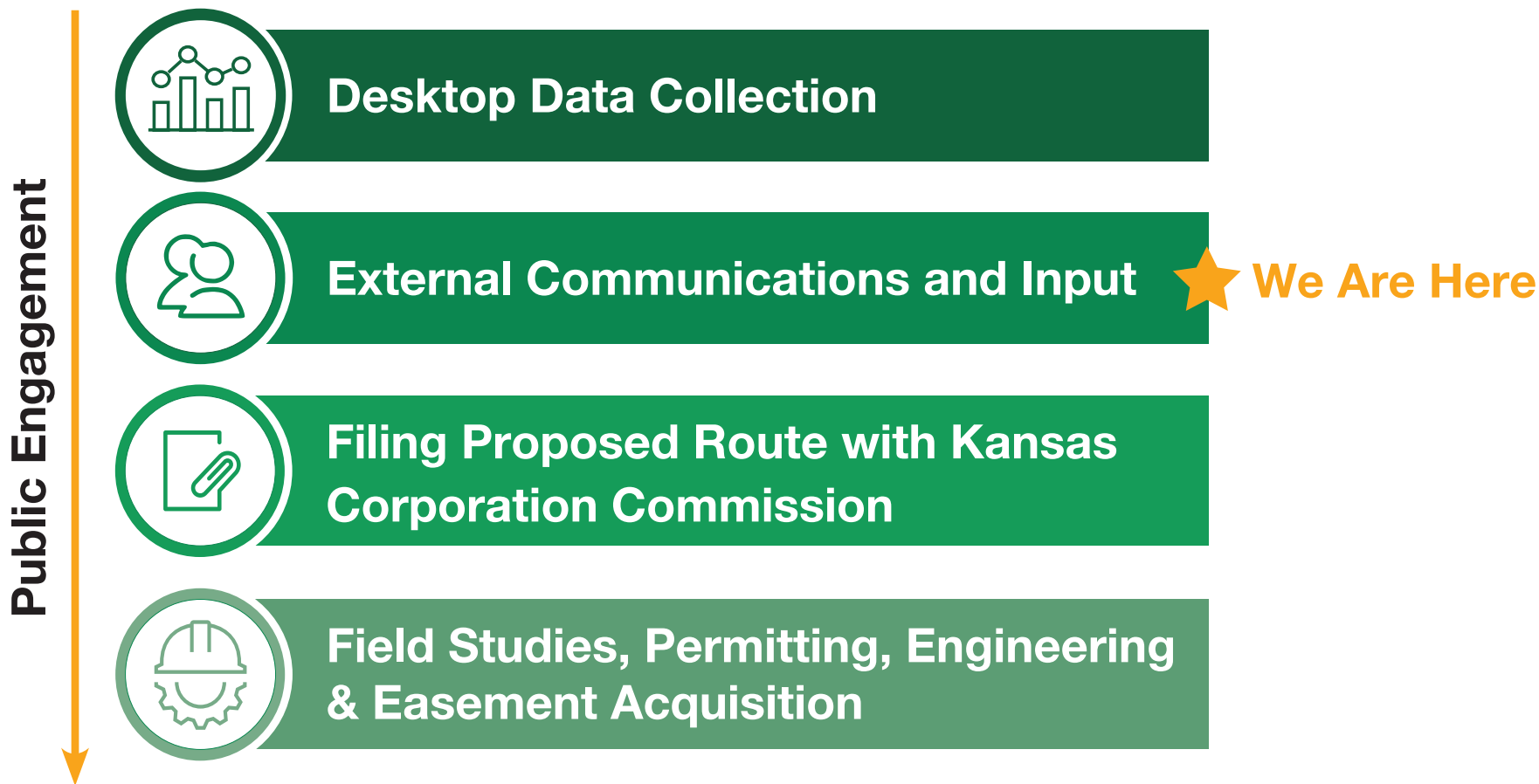

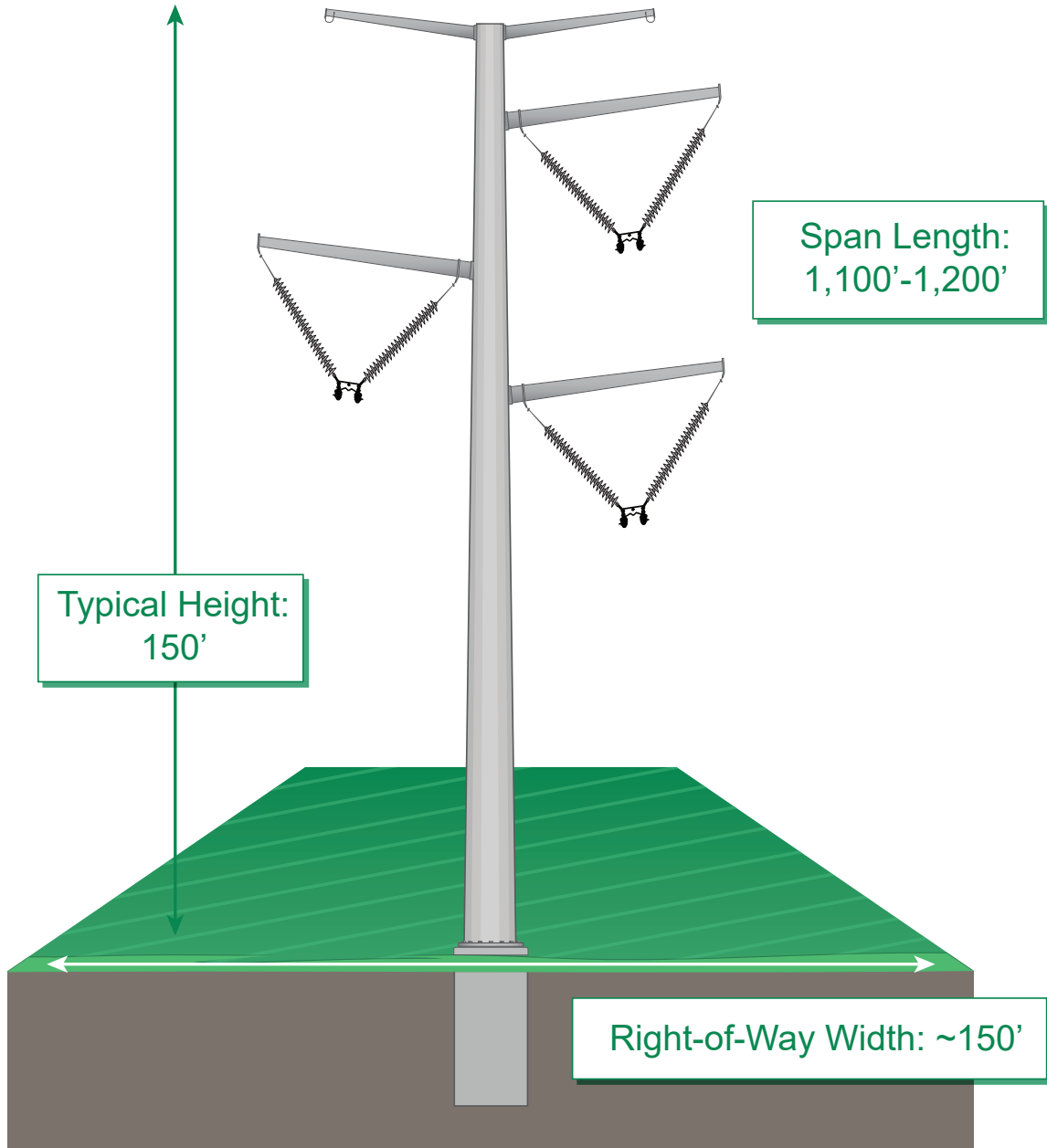

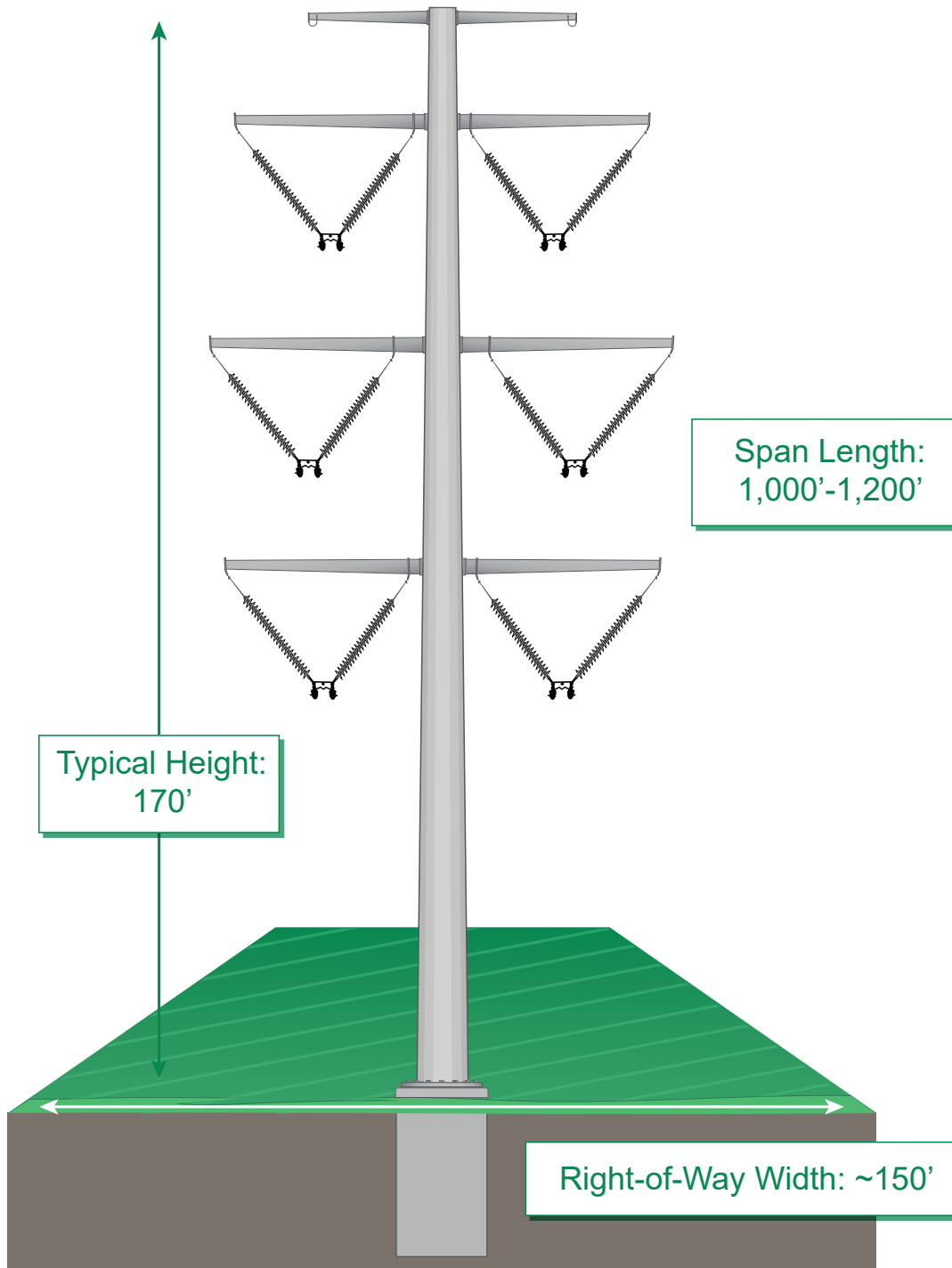
V-String Suspension Steel Pole (Single Circuit)

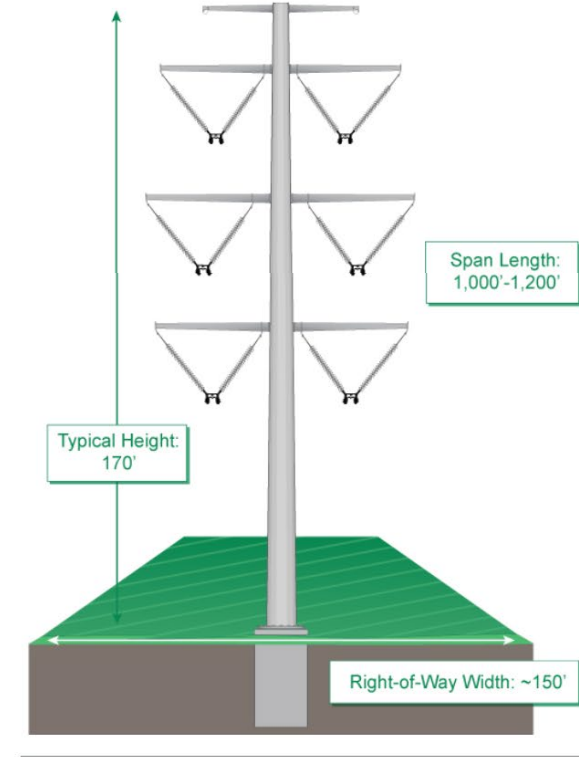
