On August 14, 2018 the KCC issued an Order Opening the docket and included KCC Staff's Report and Recommendation that the recommended affordable residential rate for RLECs be increased by \$1.25. On October 25, 2018 Staff notified RLECs that the affordable residential rate should only be increased by \$0.50.

The filing for Southern Kansas did not reflect Staff's October 25, 2018 rate increase in its Clearwater exchange. This filing contains the corrected \$0.50 increase.
