**ORDER CLOSING DOCKET**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On June 21, 2017, the Transportation Division received a complaint regarding a carrier of household goods operating without proper for-hire authority or adequate insurance. An investigation was opened and assigned to Special Investigator (SI) Verna Jackson.
2. On July 27, 2017, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Open Docket and For Issuance of Subpoena in Aid of an Investigation requesting the Commission open a docket for the purposes of issuing a Subpoena Duces Tecum in order to aid an ongoing investigation of the Transportation Division.
3. On August 7, 2017, Staff filed the Return of Completed Subpoena.
4. On August 25, 2017, Staff filed a Confidential Affidavit of Custodian of Business Records.

5. The Commission finds and concludes that the closure of the above docket is necessary and proper to promote the State's interest in the efficient administration of Kansas statutes and the Commission's regulations.

6. The Commission further finds and concludes that, from the record, it does not appear that any party to the matter in this docket will be unduly burdened or prejudiced by the closure of the above docket.

7. The Commission finds and concludes that the above docket should be closed.

**IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. For the reasons set out above, the captioned docket is hereby closed.


