PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On October 22, 2018, Abercrombie Energy, LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Mississippi formation at the Brown #1-26 well, located in Seward County, Kansas.¹ On November 20, 2019, L.H. and Thais Brown (Protestors) filed a letter of protest and request for hearing.²
 - 2. This matter is currently scheduled for a May 16, 2019, evidentiary hearing.³
- 3. At a March 19, 2019, status conference, all parties consented to the electronic service of all documents⁴ and orders.⁵ Therefore, the Prehearing Officer directs that service of all documents and orders may be made by email.
