ORDER CONSOLIDATING DOCKETS, DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 7, 2017, Eagle Energy Resources, LLC (Operator) filed applications in the above dockets for exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for the captioned wells.¹
- 2. On September 22, 2017, Operator filed Amended Applications in each of the four dockets.
- 3. On December 21, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for Consolidation of Dockets, the Designation of a Prehearing Officer, and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference noting that Staff does not recommend approval of the applications.
- 4. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-224, the Commission may consolidate two or more dockets if the issues do not require separate and distinct proof. Staff has stated the applications are the same and suffer from similar deficiencies. Therefore, for good cause show, the Commission finds and concludes that the two Dockets shall be consolidated for administrative efficiency and cost.
- 5. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-516-517.² The Commission also finds that a prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Docket Nos. 18-CONS-3078-CEXC, 18-CONS-3079-CEXC, 18-CONS-3080-CEXC, 18-CONS-3081-CEXC shall be consolidated.

At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq*. Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

F. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³ BY THE COMMISSION IT IS SO ORDERED.
