

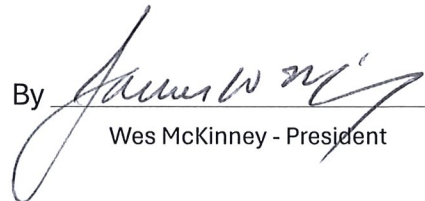

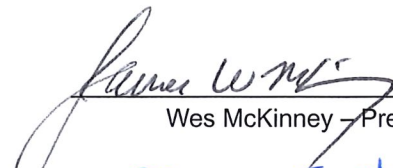

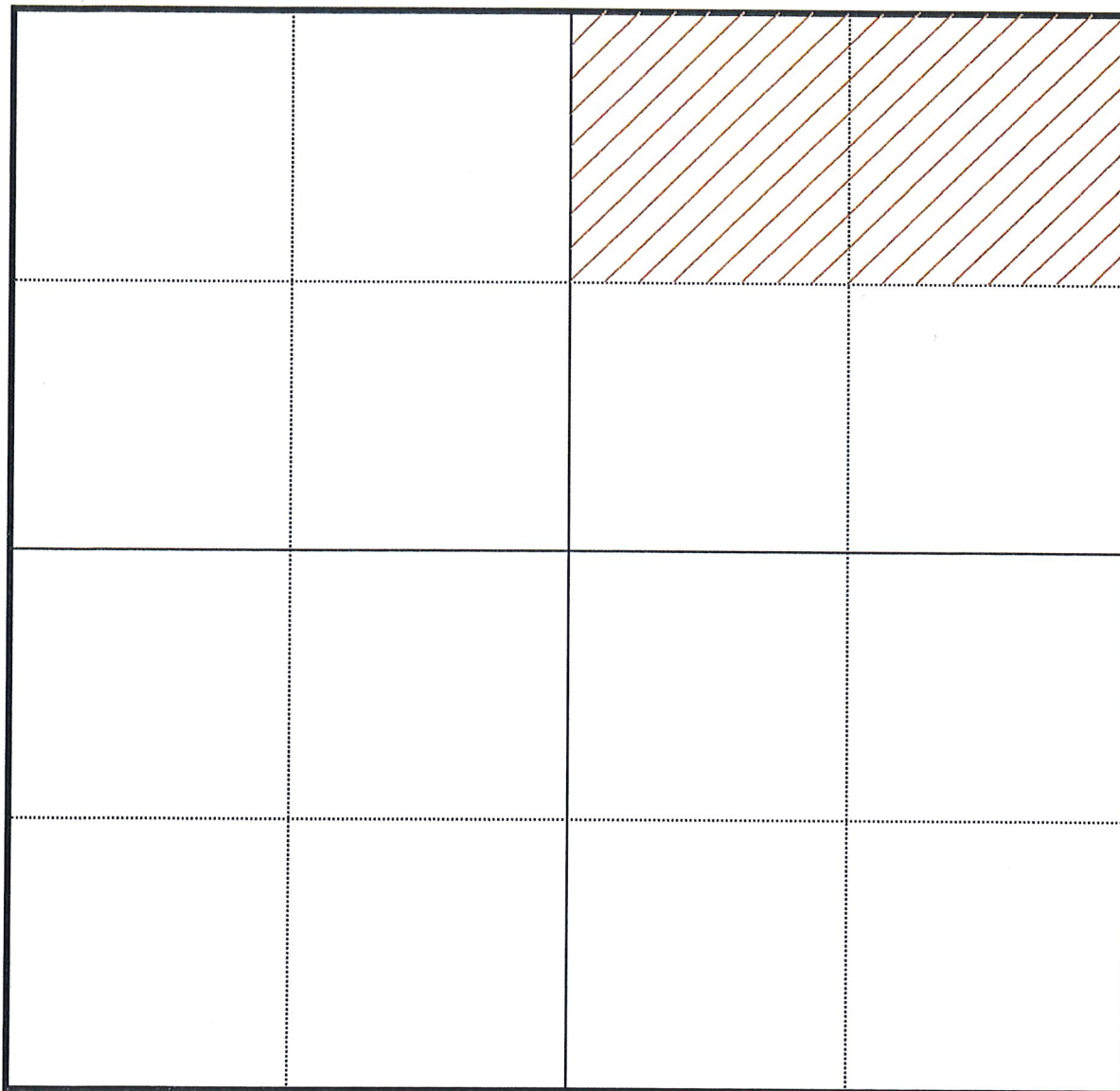

SEC. 28 TWP. 34 S RNG. 33 W



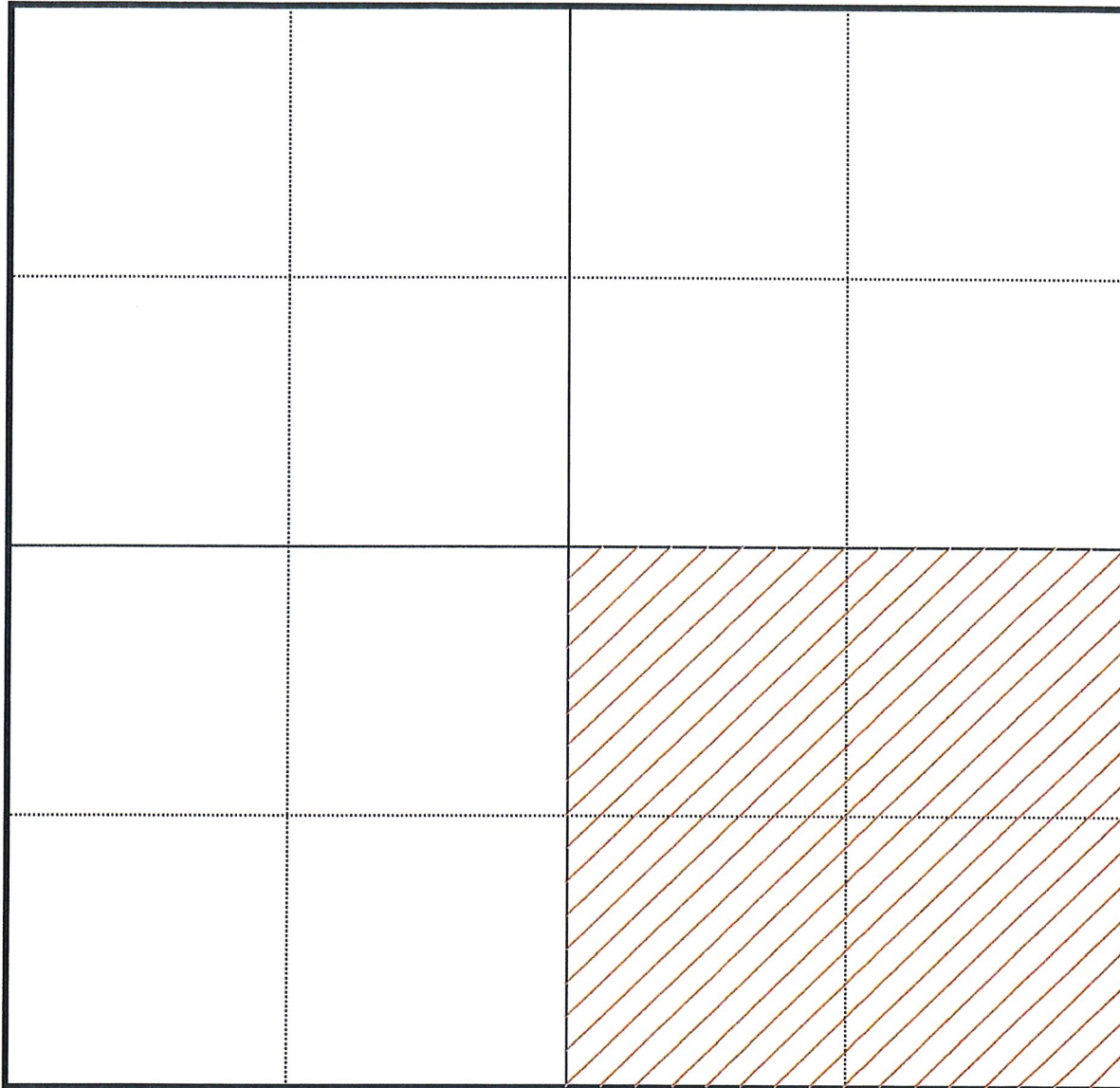
LOCATION: N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of SECTION 28,

SEC. 21 TWP. 34 S RNG. 33 W

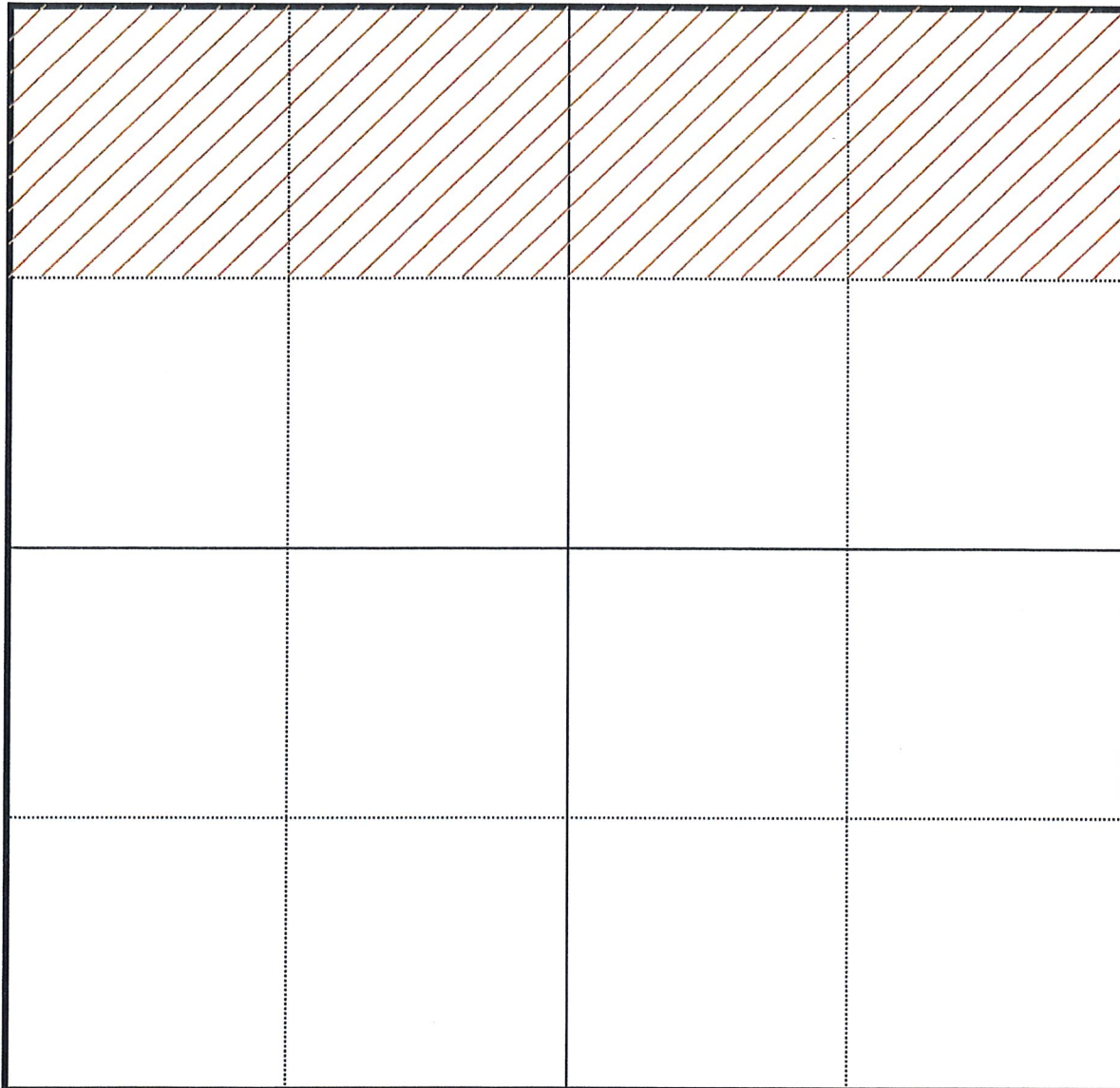


LOCATION: SE 1/4 of SECTION 21,

SEC. 27 TWP. 34 S RNG. 33 W



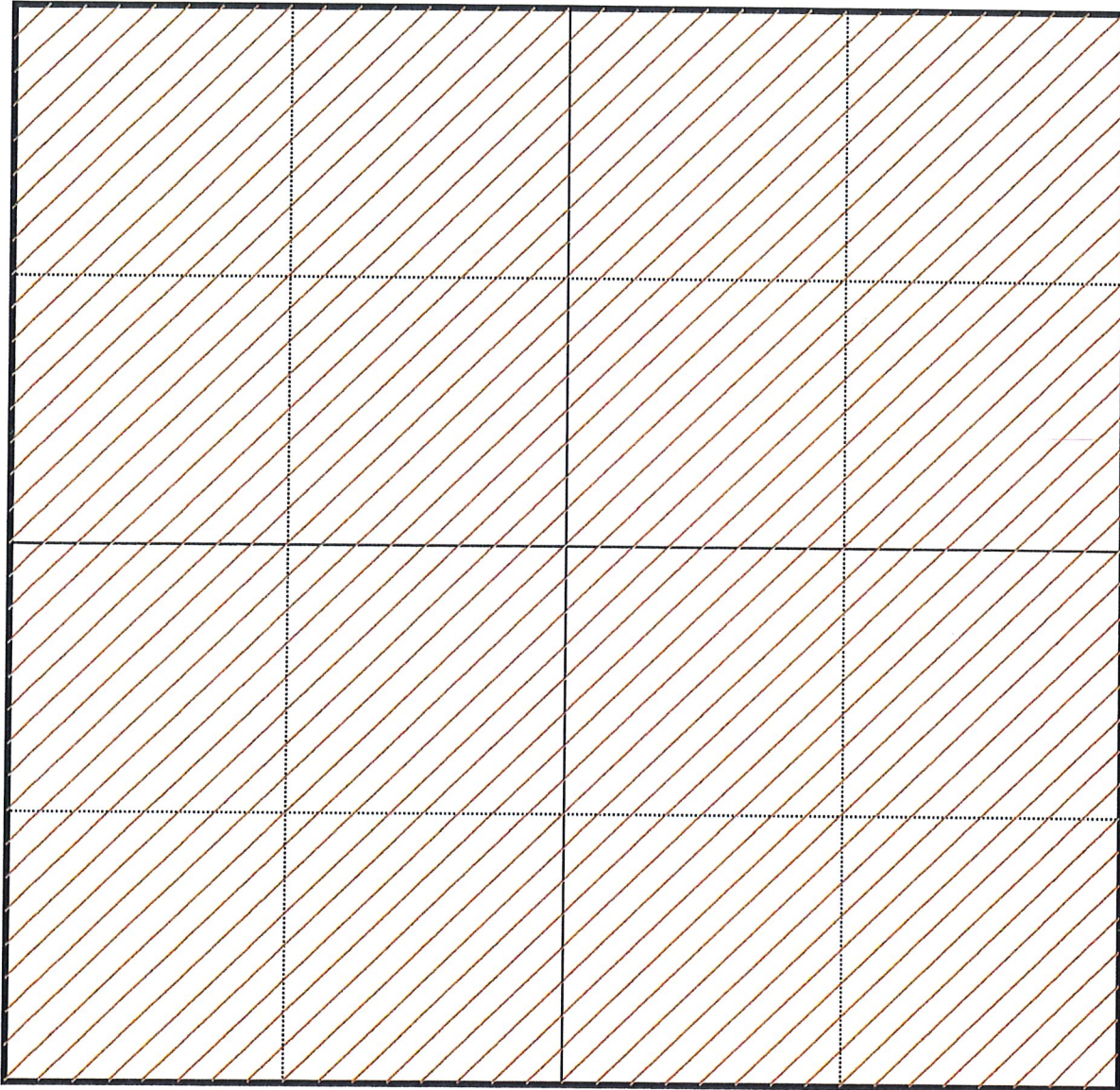
LOCATION: N 1/2 of the N 1/2 of SECTION 27,

SEC. 9 TWP. 33 S RNG. 32 W

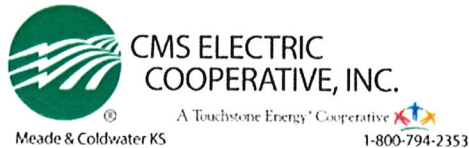


LOCATION: ALL of SECTION 29,

2. W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW1/4 Section 28, T34s, R32w;
3. N $\frac{1}{2}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29, T34s, R32w; and
4. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, T32s, R32w.

Application for Certificate of CMS Electric for territory located in Seward County, Kansas:

The subject service territory as depicted in attached Exhibit A to each of the Applications to Cease Operation and outlined in red, is located in either a rural area and currently impacts no existing retail consumers of either utility or is to clean up the service territory boundaries between the utilities around and adjacent to the City of Liberal, Kansas.

Therefore, the Southern Pioneer and CMS Electric Boards respectfully request with the filings of these Applications that the Commission approve the proposed territory exchanges in order to economically serve future retail consumers.
