ORDER HOLDING DOCKET 20-3079 MOTION TO DISMISS IN ABEYANCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

I. Procedural Background

1. On October 16, 2019, the above-captioned dockets were consolidated for hearing on a common record.¹ In both dockets, TDR Construction, Inc. (Operator) seeks injection authority on the Moldenhauer lease; in both dockets, Scott Yeargain and Polly Shteamer (Protesters) filed a protest.²

2. On September 9, 2019, Operator filed a motion to dismiss Protesters in Docket 20-

CONS-3043-CUIC; Protesters filed a response on September 10, 2019. On October 1, 2019, the Commission partially denied the motion and held the remainder in abeyance.³

3. On September 27, 2019, Operator filed a motion to dismiss Protesters in Docket 20-CONS-3079-CUIC; Protesters filed a response on October 10, 2019. No ruling has been issued.

4. These consolidated dockets are currently scheduled for a December 19, 2019, evidentiary hearing.⁴ No testimony is due until November 12, 2019; discovery is ongoing.⁵

II. Findings of Fact

5. The Commission finds it appropriate to clarify the status of Operator's motion to dismiss filed in Docket 20-3079. As the Commission found in considering the motion to dismiss in Docket 20-3043, the Commission believes additional development of the record will provide for a better opportunity to consider Protesters' standing.

III. Conclusions of Law

6. Based upon the above, the Commission shall hold Operator's arguments for dismissal of Protesters in Docket 20-3079 in abeyance pending additional proceedings.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. Operator's motion to dismiss Protesters in Docket 20-3079 shall be held in abeyance in the same manner as Operator's motion to dismiss Protesters in Docket 20-3043.
