**MOTION TO REINSTATE INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS**

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission reinstate the Kansas motor carrier operations of Glen Alan Wadel d/b/a West Rim Transport of Fredonia, Kansas (Carrier). In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

1. Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in intrastate commerce.
2. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 1882250.
3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,139a and K.A.R. 82-4-30a, motor carriers operating interstate commerce must pay Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees annually, by January 1 each year. Carrier failed to pay its annual 2022 UCR fees by January 1, 2022, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a.
4. On February 28, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations,<sup>1</sup> due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued on August 18, 2022.<sup>2</sup> The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for failing to pay its 2022 and 2023

UCR fees, as required by 49 C.F.R. 367.40 and adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-30a. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.

5. After a review of Commission records, Carrier submitted payment of the \$300 civil assessment on April 17, 2023. The deadline to pay its 2022 and 2023 UCR fees has passed, but the Carrier has paid its 2024 and 2025 UCR fees. Transportation Staff (Staff) confirmed the payments have been made as of that date and determined the carrier was now in compliance with Kansas motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations pursuant to the above-referenced Penalty Order.

6. Based on the information provided, Staff asks the Commission to find that Carrier has now complied with the requirements of the above-referenced Penalty Order and to reinstate Carrier's Kansas motor carrier operations.

**WHEREFORE**, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order reinstating Carrier's Kansas motor carrier operations.
