ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

On March 20, 2018, Urban Oil and Gas Group LLC (Operator) filed an Application 1. seeking authorization for injection of saltwater into the Arbuckle formation at the Lygrisse #82X well in Sedgwick County, Kansas.¹

2. On April 6, 2018, Benjamin M. Giles (Protestant) filed a letter of protest, and on May 7, 2018, requested a hearing.²

On May 24, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was scheduled for July 12, 2018.³ 3.

On July 12, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was held. Counsel for the Operator 4 appeared, but Staff and the Protestant did not. Counsel for the Operator stated he had no objection to continuing the Prehearing Conference. Thus, the Prehearing Officer continued the Prehearing Conference to August 9, 2018.⁴

5. On August 9, 2018 another Prehearing Conference was held. The parties agreed to continue the Prehearing Conference. The Prehearing Conference was rescheduled for September 13, 2018,⁵ wherein the parties agreed to the following procedural schedule:

6. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

7. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by October 15, 2018.

8. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities

Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

9. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other

stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.⁶

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 5 above is adopted.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁷

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
