#### ORDER GRANTING FREEDOM PIPELINE INTERVENTION

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On February 3, 2025, Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills") filed an Application requesting to increase its revenues annually by \$17,207,752, rebasing amounts currently collected through the Gas System Reliability Surcharge ("GSRS") of \$4.4 million and adjusting \$1.4 million of the Ad Valorem Tax Surcharge ("AVTS") into base rates, that will result in an overall rate of return of 7.63%.
- 2. On April 24, 2025, the Freedom Pipeline, LLC ("Freedom Pipeline") filed its Petition to Intervene. In support of its Petition to Intervene, Freedom Pipeline explains that it is a natural gas transport customer of Black Hills, and may be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.<sup>2</sup>
- 3. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the

proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties and privileges, immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.<sup>3</sup> Also, at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may impose limitations on an intervenor's participation.<sup>4</sup>

4. The Commission finds and concludes that Freedom Pipeline has met the requirements of K.A.R. 82-1-225 and K.S.A. 77-521 and should be granted intervention in this Docket. Freedom Pipeline will be added to the mailing list, and electronic service of pleadings, communications, and correspondence should be delivered to counsel of record and intervenors' other designee as follows:
