## MOTION TO SUSPEND INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), by and through its counsel, files its motion requesting the Commission suspend Glenn Alan Wadel of Fredonia, Kansas (Carrier) from all intrastate commercial motor carrier operations. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. Carrier is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5, as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, that operates commercial motor vehicle(s) in interstate commerce.
- 2. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT number 1882250.
- 3. On August 18, 2022, the Commission issued Carrier a Penalty Order that assessed a civil penalty of \$300 for failure to pay the Unified Commercial Registration (UCR) fees for 2022 this docket.<sup>1</sup>
- 4. Carrier was sent a collection letter on January 6, 2023, reminding it of the amount due and giving it 10 days from the date of the collection letter to pay. A copy of the collection letter is attached hereto.

5. As of February 22, 2023, Commission records indicate that Carrier has not complied with the collection letter or the requirements of the Penalty Order.

6. Staff asks the Commission find that Carrier's failure to comply with the

requirements of the Penalty Order poses a potential immediate threat to the safety and welfare of

the public of the state of Kansas.

7. Based on the presented facts, Staff requests the Commission issue an order

suspending Carrier's intrastate motor carrier operations until such time as Carrier pays the

penalty of \$300 as well as its 2022 and 2023 UCR fees, at which time Staff will recommend the

Commission enter an order of reinstatement of intrastate motor carrier operations.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the

Commission issue an order suspending Carrier's intrastate motor carrier.

On August 18, 2022, a Penalty Order was issued against Glenn Alan Wadel for violations of motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations. The order assessed it a civil penalty of \$300.

To date, this civil penalty has not been paid, nor has evidence been provided to the Commission to avoid sending this matter to a collection agency and/or submission to the Kansas state setoff program for the garnishment of any tax refund that might be due you. Please remit payment of \$300 along with any unpaid UCR fees for 2022, through your personal account in the Kansas Corporation Commission's KTRAN application located at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</a>. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed and any unpaid UCR fees for 2022. Payment must be made within the next 10 days.

This letter further serves as notice that operation of a commercial motor vehicle in violation of a Commission Penalty Order may subject your company to additional civil penalties and sanctions, including the issuance and enforcement of out-of-service orders and possible impoundments.
