Re: Protest of Berexco LLC's Second Exception to the 10-Year Time Limitation
of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for its Garden City A #4-29 Well

Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter is to inform you of Bayshore Energy KS LLC's ("Bayshore") strong protest regarding Berexco LLC's ("Berexco") application for a second exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for its Garden City A #4-29 well (the "Well").

The Well is subject to a farmout agreement between Texaco Inc, predecessors in title to the Well, and Berexco. Pursuant to the farmout agreement, should the well need to be plugged and abandoned, the Farmor (Bayshore) shall take over operations of the Well and the Farmee (Berexco) shall relinquish all right, title, and interest to the area pertaining to the drillsite tract and materials and equipment thereon.

As the Berexco states in its application, the Well has been temporarily abandoned since December 12, 2001, and has not served any significant purpose since that time. This application is an attempt by Berexco to delay the inevitable relinquishment of its right, title, and interest pertaining to the Well and the area, materials, and equipment associated with the Well, pursuant to the farmout agreement.

As such, it is Bayshore's strong urging and request that the Commission deny this application.
