PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CLOSING DOCKETS

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Prehearing Officer finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 7, 2017, Eagle Energy Resources, LLC (Operator) filed applications in the above dockets for exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for the captioned wells.
- 2. On September 22, 2017, Operator filed Amended Applications in each of the four dockets.
- 3. On December 21, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for Consolidation of Dockets, the Designation of a Prehearing Officer, and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference noting that Staff does not recommend approval of the applications.
- 4. On February 15, 2018, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer in accordance with K.S.A. 77-551(c) to address any scheduling or procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b).
- 5. On April 30, 2018, the Operator filed a Withdrawal of Application citing that three of the subject wells had been plugged and the remaining was returned to service.¹
- 6. On May 1, 2018, the Prehearing Officer convened a Prehearing Conference at which only Commission Conservation Staff appeared and voiced no objection to the withdrawal of the applications.
- 7. The Operator desires to withdraw the applications and has taken such action as to no longer necessitate exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111. There is no objection to the Operator's motion. There is no need for further Commission action. Pursuant to the Prehearing Officer's delegation under K.S.A. 77-551(c) to handle procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b), the Prehearing Officer finds that the dockets should be closed, and therefore grants the Operator's request.
