**ORDER RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDER SUSPENDING AUTHORITY FOR  
FAILURE TO MAINTAIN INSURANCE COVERAGE**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1.       On 11/26/2019, an Emergency Order Suspending Authority for Failure to Maintain Insurance Coverage (Suspension Order) was issued by the Commission in 20-TRAM-5035-TRA for BURLINGTON VETERINARY TRANSPORT LLC.
2.       On 01/17/2017, BURLINGTON VETERINARY TRANSPORT LLC submitted evidence of valid insurance coverage to Transportation Staff of the Kansas Corporation Commission (Staff). Staff determined that there had been no lapse in insurance coverage.
3.       After a review of BURLINGTON VETERINARY TRANSPORT LLC's operations and the evidence of valid insurance coverage, Staff found the Suspension Order should be rescinded by the Commission.
4.       Staff recommends the Suspension Order be rescinded and the Commission finds this reasonable.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. The Commission's Emergency Order Suspending Authority for Failure to Maintain Insurance Coverage with regard to BURLINGTON VETERINARY TRANSPORT LLC, issued on 11/26/2019, shall be rescinded.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein pursuant to K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).


C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
