This letter is to inform you that your challenge concerning violation(s) **383.23A2** – **Operating a CMV without a CDL**, has been **DENIED**. Please see guidance below

- It is the driver's responsibility to know when their medical card expires and should submit an updated medical examiner's certificate to KDOR's office prior to the expiration date. If you do not provide KDOR with an updated medical card before it expires, the Commercial Driver's License Information System (CDLIS) will be notified immediately, and your physical qualification status in CDLIS will be changed to "not certified."
- Please refer back to CFR §383.71 Driver application and certification procedures for further guidance
- Drivers medical certificate was not certified until 11/07/2019 with KDOR.

The violation(s) will remain on your carrier profile and Invoice **# H000583378** remains valid. Please see the invoice for information regarding the fines due. Failure to pay will result in the carrier being in default. Default status prohibits changes to KCC authority, including but not limited to: adding vehicles, name changes or renewal of authority until the fine has been paid or the matter is resolved.

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of your challenge by the KHP, you have the right to an administrative hearing with the Kansas Corporation Commission. The hearing request must be in writing and received <u>WITHIN 15 DAYS</u> of the close of the challenge and forwarded to the Kansas Highway Patrol at the above address.
