- 1 Q. What is your name and business address?
- 2 A. Kenny Sullivan, 210 E. Frontview, Suite A, Dodge City, Kansas, 67801.
- 3 Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- A. I am employed by the Conservation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission
 (Commission), District #1 Office, as the District #1 Professional Geologist Supervisor.
- 6 Q. Would you please briefly describe your background and work experience?
- 7 A. I received my Bachelor Degree in Geology from Fort Hays State University in 2011.
- 8 Additionally, I received a professional geology license from the State of Kansas in 2021. I
- 9 have worked at the Commission for over eleven years. I was an Environmental Compliance
- 10 and Regulatory Specialist (ECRS) for three years, a Geology Specialist for six years, and I
- 11 have been the District #1 Supervisor for the past two years.
- 12 Q. What duties does your position with the Conservation Division entail?
- 13 A. I oversee the daily operations of the District #1 Office as they relate to oil and gas activities.
- 14 I currently supervise one Geology Specialist, ten ECRS's, and one Administrative Specialist.
- 15 Q. Have you previously testified before this Commission?
- 16 A. Yes.

17 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this matter?

18 A. The purpose of my testimony is to discuss the evidence supporting the Commission's findings

- 19 relating to the Order Denying Application for License issued to KanOK Energy, LLC
- 20 (Operator) in Docket 22-CONS-3473-CMSC (Docket 22-3473).

| 1 | Q. | What are your responsibilities in the review of the license application submitted by |

| 2 | | Operator in this docket? |
| 3 | A. | My responsibilities as the District #1 Supervisor are to provide oversight for the inspection of |
| 4 | | Operator's leases, to assist in analyzing the data collected by the ECRS Staff when inspecting |
| 5 | | those leases, and to coordinate information between Conservation Division District #1 Staff |
| 6 | | and Legal Staff. |
| 7 | Q. | Where are Operator's wells located? |
| 8 | A. | All the wells on Operator's license are located in counties overseen by District #1 Staff. A list |
| 9 | | of Operator's wells is attached to this testimony as <i>Exhibit KS-1</i> . |
| 10 | Q. | When did Operator first receive a license? |
| 11 | A. | Operator first received a license from the Commission on January 10, 2017. |
| 12 | Q. | After receiving a license, has Operator been in violation of any Commission rules or |
| 13 | | regulations? |
| 14 | A. | As <i>Exhibit KS-2</i> shows, since 2017, Operator has received eleven penalty or shut-in orders |
| 15 | | from the Commission. I would note that in Docket 19-CONS-3162-CPEN, Operator received |
| 16 | | a temporary abandonment (TA) violation at the Amigo #31-399 well. Less than four years |
| 17 | | later, in Docket 22-CONS-3292-CPEN, Operator received another TA violation for the same |
| 18 | | well. Additionally, in Docket 17-CONS-3544-CPEN, Operator received a Shut-In Order and |
| 19 | | \$2,500 penalty from the Commission for operating on a suspended license. Less than four |
| 20 | | years later, in Docket 22-CONS-3418-CPEN, Operator received another Shut-In Order and a |
| 21 | | \$25,000 penalty from the Commission for operating on a suspended license. |

1 Q. How many times has Operator's license been suspended?

A. As *Exhibit KS-3* shows, since 2017, Operator's license has been suspended ten times. In fact,
Operator's license has been suspended in every single penalty docket opened by the
Commission. In two of those instances, Operator's license was suspended for more than a
year before Operator brought itself back into compliance with Commission orders.

Q. Do you believe Operator's compliance issues indicate a disregard for Commission rules and regulations?

A. Yes, I believe Operator's compliance issues demonstrate a disregard for the Commission's
rules and regulations. Operator has received eleven penalty and shut-in orders in a little over
five years, as well as ten license suspensions in the same amount of time. Operator's actions
place a burden on District #1 resources, and are an impediment to Staff's ability to accomplish
other tasks.
