ORDER ADOPTING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On September 1, 2017, the Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC), Kansas Gas and Electric Company d/b/a Westar Energy (Westar), Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L), and Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo) (collectively referred to as the Parties) jointly submitted the Decommissioning Financing Plan for the Wolf Creek Generating Station (Wolf Creek). The 2017 triennial Decommissioning Cost Study for Wolf Creek is included in the Decommissioning Financing Plan.¹

2. On December 28, 2017, WCNOC, Westar, KCP&L, KEPCo, Commission Staff, and CURB² filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Schedule for the Commission's review and approval.

3. After reviewing the Joint Motion, the Commission adopts the following procedural schedule:


THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:
