This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Twisted Towing LLC (Twisted Towing) for violation(s) of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted on August 17, 2023, by Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator Doug Handy. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 29, 2023. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

**IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY:** Twisted Towing has been assessed a \$100 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$100, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</a>. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

**IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing.** A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Twisted Towing must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/</a>, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.1

**IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:** Failure to pay the penalty of \$100 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

### **PENALTY ORDER**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 17, 2024, Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) Doug Handy, completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Twisted Towing, LLC (Twisted Towing or Carrier). Twisted Towing is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 3384558.
- 2. On October 11, 2023, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation (R&R), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$100 to be issued to Twisted Towing based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigations, SI Doug Handy identified one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) count, of the

Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carry a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.<sup>2</sup>

- 3. Staff further recommends Twisted Towing submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.<sup>3</sup>
- 4. Finally, Staff recommends that Twisted Towing submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.<sup>4</sup> Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.
- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, 66-1,114b and 66-1,115, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 391.25 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.

7. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

### IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Twisted Towing, LLC, of Wichita, Kansas is hereby assessed a \$100 civil penalty for one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) count, of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.

B.

Carrier is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

- C. Twisted Towing is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.
- D. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/</a>, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not

have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of «Short Name»'s right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.

- E. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties less than \$500, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.<sup>5</sup>
- F. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$100 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$100 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.
- G. Failure to pay the \$100 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of Twisted Towing's motor carrier operating authority without further notice. Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Twisted Towing LLC is a motor carrier (MC) possessing public for-hire and private operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling motor vehicles and driveaway/towaway. Twisted Towing LLC operates under USDOT 3384558. On August 17, 2023, Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) Doug Handy completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Twisted Towing LLC. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified one (1) violation(s), accounting for one (1) specific count(s), of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carry a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, Staff recommends penalty of \$100 be issued to the MC.

# **DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:**

On August 17, 2023, Commission Staff SI Doug Handy conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Twisted Towing LLC. The investigation covers a 365 day period. Each specific count is detailed below.

# Count One (1 of 1)

**Jurisdiction:** 49 C.F.R. 391.25, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129

<u>Intent of Law:</u> The MC must make an inquiry every 12 months into the annual motor vehicle record (MVR) of its driver.

<u>Supporting Documentation</u>: On May 31, 2023, Twisted Towing LLC required or permitted its driver to operate a commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 2019 Peterbilt, VIN ending in 9419, GVWR 26,000 lbs., in intrastate commerce in Wichita, Kansas. This transport is evidenced by the carrier's driver commission report, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**. Additionally attached is an MVR dated January 20, 2022, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**. The MC was unable to provide a MVR obtained after this date or within the one year prior to this transport.

<u>Violation:</u> Twisted Towing LLC failed to obtain MVR for the driver involved in this transport (Exhibit 1, Page 3). One (1) violation was discovered.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends a fine of \$100.


### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find Twisted Towing LLC committed one (1) violation(s), accounting for one (1) specific counts, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$100 for one (1) violation(s) of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends Twisted Towing LLC submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that Twisted Towing LLC submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.




