ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER & SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

1. On March 5, 2015, Grand Mesa filed an application for injection authority at the Vesecky #1-9I, Vesecky #1-6I, Vesecky #3-7I, and Vesecky #3-4I wells. On March 23, 2015, the Commission received a letter from Al Hack, objecting to injection at the Vesecky #1-9I, Vesecky #1-6I, and Vesecky #3-7I. On March 24, 2015, Commission Staff sent a letter to Mr. Hack, asking whether he felt a hearing should be scheduled. On April 3, 2015, Mr. Hack sent a letter explicitly requesting a hearing.

2. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this

proceeding to address any matters listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b). The Commission also finds that an

initial prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

B. A Prehearing Conference is scheduled for Tuesday, May 12, 2015. The Prehearing Conference shall begin at 1:30 p.m. and end by 2:30 p.m., at the Commission's offices, 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Telephonic attendance may be permitted. The Prehearing Conference will focus on the development of a procedural schedule.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, scheduling of a hearing with the Commission, and any other issues that will promote the orderly and prompt resolution of this proceeding.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act ("KAPA"). <u>Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding shall be held in default under the KAPA.</u>

E. <u>Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2), corporations must enter an appearance via an</u> attorney. If a corporation fails to enter an appearance via an attorney prior to the Prehearing <u>Conference, it shall be held in default under the KAPA.</u>
