CUSTOMER NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO KCC CERTIFICATE

TO: All Intrastate Shippers on ONEOK NGL Pipeline, L.L.C. in the State of Kansas

RE: Docket No. 15-ONEP-329-COC at the Kansas Corporation Commission

On January 30, 2015, ONEOK NGL Pipeline, L.L.C. filed an application with the Kansas Corporation Commission requesting permission to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity to transact the business of a liquids pipeline common carrier in the State of Kansas.

The new route ONEOK NGL Pipeline, L.L.C. seeks to serve is from Bushton, Kansas to Conway, Kansas. The new tariff rate relating to this new route was filed for approval in Docket No. 15-ONEP-297-TAR.

The application may be acted upon within thirty days of the filing. If you would like to protest this filing, you should do so within the thirty day period. You may file a protest in one of three manners:

- You may intervene in the docket by having an attorney submit a petition for intervention in accordance with K.A.R. 82-1-225 and filing a written protest; or
