## MOTION FOR ORDER AMENDING PENALTY ASSESSMENT

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through its counsel, Ahsan A. Latif, files this Motion requesting the Commission issue an Order Amending Penalty Assessment reducing the penalty assessed to Concrete Service Co., Inc. (Concrete Service), in the Penalty Order dated August 28, 2018. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On August 28, 2018, a Penalty Order was issued to Concrete Service assessing it an enhanced penalty of \$2,000 for one (1) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations. The violation was found during a Safety Compliance Review conducted on July 6, 2018, by Special Investigator Jared Smith.
- 1. Transportation Staff and a representative from Concrete Services had a discussion in the beginning of September 2018, regarding the enhanced penalty amount and Staff determined from information provided by the carrier that the violation was not intentional and the penalty amount should not be enhanced.
- 2. Staff recommends the Commission issue an Order Amending Penalty Assessment assessing Concrete Service a reduced penalty of \$1,000.

3. Concrete Services is planning to attend a Safety Education Seminar in Hutchinson on November 5, 2018. It has submitted a Corrective Action Plan which has been approved by Transportation Staff. The carrier will make itself available after 18 months for another compliance review.

4. Staff recommends that the Commission find that Concrete Services has satisfied the requirements of the Penalty Order and that based upon the discovery of further information, the enhanced fine should be reduced from \$2,000 to \$1,000.

**WHEREFORE,** for the reasons set forth herein, Staff requests an Order Amending Penalty Assessment be issued by the Commission assessing Concrete Service Co., Inc. a reduced penalty of \$1,000.
