To Whom it May Concern:

I William James Lytton landowner at 8853 SW 95<sup>th</sup> Augusta KS protest the proposed Scully A3 Injection well. Proposed well location N/2, N2, SE/4 and SW/4.

In this general area there approx 10 families which are totally dependent on well water, therefore this is a major concern. Recent water wells drilled in this area at at depth of 120' have already shown the contamination of salt water. Records show pressurized injection wells drilled to bury this waste deep beneath the ground have repeatedly leaked, sending dangerous chemicals and waste gurgling to the surface or, on occasion, seeping into shallow aquifers that store a significant portion of the nations drinking water.

There is data that suggests earthquakes can be triggered by fluid injection. USGS studies and other studies have found that at some locations the increase in seismicity coincides with the injection of wastewater in deep disposal wells. Fluid injection near a fault under a certain set of conditions can cause a fault to move, resulting in an earthquake.

As a landowner of this area, I hope you will address my objections to the permit as it is evaluated.
