

II. STAFF'S FINDING OF FACTS

4. On or about November 18, 2024, Staff received a notification from THE MOTOR CARRIER that USDOT ID 2827041 was subject to abandonment due to Insurance.

5. PUMPHREY TRUCKING LLC's Certificate of Public Service issued by the Commission on March 18, 2021, authorized operation as a common motor carrier in the transportation of general commodities, other than household goods, passengers or hazardous materials, in intrastate commerce as authorized by K.S.A 66-1,114b.

6. Commission Staff (Staff) has examined its files and records and has not located evidence of unresolved safety concerns, violations or civil penalties associated with the motor carrier's current certificate.

III. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

7. Staff recommends that the Commission grant PUMPHREY TRUCKING LLC Request for Abandonment of Certificate of Public Service identified by USDOT Number 2827041.

IV. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Based upon the available facts, the Commission finds that Staff's recommendation to grant PUMPHREY TRUCKING LLC's Request for Abandonment of Certificate of Public Service, is reasonable under the circumstances.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) PUMPHREY TRUCKING LLC's Request for Abandonment of Certificate of Public Service is hereby granted.

(B) The common operating authority certificate issued to PUMPHREY TRUCKING LLC on March 18, 2021, identified by USDOT Number 2827041, is hereby cancelled.

(C) This Order constitutes a summary order, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537, and is subject to a party's request for a hearing. A party may request a hearing on the above issues by

servicing a written request for hearing on the Commission's Transportation Division at 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604 within fifteen (15) days of the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing, but three (3) days shall be added to the allowed time. If a hearing is not requested, the Order shall become effective upon the expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. Moreover, upon being served with this Order, a party may waive its right to a hearing.¹ The Order shall become effective upon such waiver.

(D) A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing, but three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame.²

(E) A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³


(F) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
