SUSPENSION ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On January 15, 2015, ONEOK NGL Pipeline, L.L.C. (ONGL) filed an Application with the Commission seeking approval of Tariff No. 9.

2. Commission Staff (Staff) has determined that an additional 240 days is needed to fully review ONGL's Application and suspension is required to allow sufficient time for Staff's review and investigation of this matter. Although Staff reserves the full 240 days, Staff recognizes the need for efficient use of Commission resources and time and will thus strive to complete its Report and Recommendation by Monday, February 16, 2015.

3. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of the application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. The application should be suspended for a period of 240 days from the date the application was made, January 15, 2015, until September 12, 2015, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c). However, given the end of the 240-day suspension period falls on a weekend, the

deadline for Commission Order in this matter is Monday, September 14, 2015, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c) and K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 77-503(c).


IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), the application in the above-captioned docket shall be suspended and the effective date deferred until September 14, 2015.
- B. The parties have 15 days, plus three (3) days if service is by mail, from the date the order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
