ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On May 1, 2019, The Victory Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. (Victory) filed an Application requesting approval to update its Local Access Delivery Service (LADS) tariff.¹
- 2. On May 14, 2019, the Commission issued a *Suspension Order*, deferring the effective date of Victory's Application until December 27, 2019.²
- 3. On May 14, 2019, Susan B. Cunningham entered her appearance on behalf of Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo).
- 4. On May 23, 2019, Victory, KEPCo and Commission Staff (Staff) (collectively, Joint Movants) filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Order, requesting the schedule set forth in the Joint Motion.³ Having reviewed the Joint Motion, the Commission adopts the following schedule:

The Commission may designate other Staff members to serve in this capacity.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 4 of this Order is adopted.
- B. Michael J. Duenes is designated as the Prehearing Officer.

- C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁴
- D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
