To Whom It May Concern:

My husband and I are writing regarding the application by the Double D Oil Company to convert the Howard Moon #1 oil well into a salt water disposal well for produced water off of the Moon B lease. Though the Moon family has decades of cooperative work with the various operators of the Moon B lease over time, we are writing to protest the request by the Double D Oil Company to use the Howard Moon #1 oil well as a disposal well. Not only has the maintenance of the well sites been negligent and therefore hazardous to the environment, we have grave concern for the future of the fresh water well on our property. There has already been oil contamination to one of the two water wells on the Moon B lease property. Now, our concern is for the protection of the remaining usable water well, located ¼ of a mile south of the proposed disposal well and is the only source of fresh water to our property. Since the underground water flow is from north to south and the Howard Moon #1 oil well is north of the water well and elevated on a hill, we are concerned that if there were a leak in the well casing, the water well would be contaminated by the salt water from the disposal well. The depth of the surface casing in the Howard Moon #1 oil well is at the minimum required by law. Its depth is very near the same level of our water well. If the casing were to leak, our source of water would likely be contaminated and permanently damaged. For this reason, we are protesting the use of the Howard Moon #1 oil well for the purposes of disposing of all produced water.
