PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. The Commission has designated Samuel Feather, Deputy General Counsel, to act as Prehearing Officer in this proceeding. Having reviewed the files and records, and being duly advised, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

Background

- 1. On April 28, 2017, Berexco, LLC (Operator) filed an application for an additional exception to the 10-year limitation for the Garden City A #4-29 well Located in the SW NW NW of Sec 29, T22S, R33W, Finney County, Kansas.
- 2. On May 22, 2017, Bayshore Energy KS, LLC (Protestant) filed a protest of the application.
- 3. On June 6, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference. The Commission scheduled a prehearing conference for July 17, 2017.
 - 4. On July 13, 2017, Protestants filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest.

the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
