The second violation is described as "False report of drivers record of duty status". This truck, like all of our trucks, is equipped with an ELD. The brand of the device is Verizon Reveal. Occasionally these devices fail to work properly due to signal loss with cell service. When that happens, and our drivers become aware of it, they do a paper log for any hours that may be included in an ELD outage. Our driver did have a paper log for the period in question.
