Victory proposed to decrease its LADS demand charge assessed on the wholesale users of its 34.5kV system from \$1.73 per kW to \$1.13 per kW in accordance with the 34.5kV Formula Based Rate plan approved in Docket 16-MKEE-023-TAR.
