

will be sufficient to cover the cost of its Gas Hedge Program for the winter period of 2014-2015. Therefore, Black Hills requests permission to discontinue billing its customers the monthly gas hedge charge for the months of August, September, and October, 2014. Black Hills indicates that revised costs for the company's Gas Hedge Program for the 2014-2015 winter season is estimated at \$1,000,000 to \$1,300,000. As of May 31, 2014, Black Hills states that it has collected approximately \$1,350,000, a sufficient amount to cover the cost of its Gas Hedge Program for the upcoming winter period. Consequently, Black Hills is requesting that it be allowed to discontinue billing its customers the gas hedge charge for the remaining three months of the recovery period, which includes the months of August, September, and October, 2014. Motion at ¶s 1 and 2.

4. The Commission, having reviewed Black Hills' Motion and Staff's Response, finds that Black Hills' request to discontinue billing its customers the monthly gas hedge charge for the three remaining months in the Hedge Program recovery period is reasonable, in the public interest, and should be granted. Staff and CURB, the only other parties to this docket, have no objection to Black Hills' request.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) The Motion filed July 10, 2014 by Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC d/b/a Black Hills Energy, requesting to discontinue billing its customers the monthly Gas Hedge Program charge through the remainder of the recovery period, which includes the months of August, September, and October, 2014, is hereby granted.


