PENALTY ORDER

The above captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined the files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-623, the Commission shall have the exclusive jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and gas activities.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 55-162, whenever the Commission, from investigation or upon written complaint filed with the Commission, finds reasonable cause to believe that a person has violated any provision of K.S.A. 55-150 *et seq.*, or any rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 55-150 *et seq.*, the Commission shall cause such person to come before it at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). After such hearing, if the Commission finds that such person violated any provisions of K.S.A. 55-150 *et seq.*, the Commission shall take any appropriate action necessary to prevent pollution and protect water supply.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164, in addition to any other penalty provided by law, the Commission, upon finding that an operator or contractor has violated the provisions of K.S.A.

55-150 et seq., or any rule and regulation or order of the Commission, may impose a penalty not to exceed \$10,000, which shall constitute an actual and substantial economic deterrent to the violation for which the penalty is assessed. In the case of continuing violation, every day such violation continues shall be deemed a separate violation.

- 4. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-111, within 90 days after operations cease on any well drilled for the purpose of exploration, discovery, service, or production of oil, gas, or other minerals, the operator of that well shall either (1) plug the well, (2) return the well to service, or (3) file an application with the Conservation Division requesting temporary abandonment ("TA") authority, on a form prescribed by the Conservation Division. A well shall not be eligible for TA status if the well has been shut in for 10 years or more without an application for an exception pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-100 and approval by the Commission. The failure to file a notice of temporary abandonment shall be punishable by a \$100 penalty.
- 5. K.A.R. 82-3-111(e) provides an exemption for certain wells that are (1) fully equipped and capable of production of oil or gas or for injection; (2) capable of immediately resuming production of oil or gas or of injection; (3) subject to a valid continuing oil and gas lease; when (4) the cessation period for the well is less than 365 days; and (5) the well is otherwise in full compliance with all of the commission's regulations.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 6. Operator conducts oil and gas activities in Kansas under license number 32874.
- 7. Operator is responsible for the care and control of the following wells, all located in Township 29 South, Range 9 East, Elk County, Kansas.
 - a. Daves #D21, API #15-049-21631-00-00, located in Section 27;
 - b. Smith A #2, API #15-049-21717-00-00, located in Section 28;

- c. Smith B #10, API # 15-049-21865-00-00, located in Section 21; and
- d. Smith B #12, API #15-049-21954-00-00, located in Section 21.
- 8. District Staff inspected the subject wells and collected evidence indicating the subject wells have been inactive and unplugged for longer than the 90 days allowed by K.A.R. 82-3-111. A copy of the inspection is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference. The wells did not appear to be exempt pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-111(e). Operator either did not file TA applications or did not bring the wells into compliance after TA applications were denied.
- 9. District Staff sent letters to Operator, requiring Operator to bring the subject wells into compliance with K.A.R. 82-3-111 by September 6, 2016. Copies of the letters are attached hereto as Attachment "B" and are hereby incorporated by reference.
- 10. District Staff inspected the subject wells after the deadline in the letters passed, verifying that the wells continued to be inactive and unplugged. A copy of the inspections is attached hereto as Attachment "C" and is hereby incorporated by reference.
- 11. District Staff collected evidence and submitted it to the Legal Department with a recommendation that the Commission issue this Order. The recommendation sheets submitted by District Staff are attached to this Order as Attachment "D" and hereby incorporated by reference, and shall serve as the concise and explicit statement of facts required by K.S.A. 77-526.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 12. The Commission concludes that it has jurisdiction over Operator and this matter under K.S.A. 55-152 and K.S.A. 74-623.
- 13. The above findings of fact are sufficient evidence to support the conclusion that Operator committed four violation(s) of K.A.R. 82-3-111 because the subject wells have been

inactive in excess of the time allowed by regulation without being plugged, returned to service, or approved for TA status.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. Operator shall pay a \$400 penalty.
- B. Operator shall plug the subject wells, return the subject wells to service, or obtain TA status for the subject wells if eligible. Obtaining TA status shall include application for, and Commission approval of, an exception to the 10-year limit on TA status if applicable.
- C. If no party requests a hearing, and Operator is not in compliance with this Order within 30 days, then Operator's license shall be suspended without further notice. The notice and opportunity for a hearing on this order shall constitute the notice required by K.S.A. 77-512 regarding license suspension. The Commission may impose further sanctions, including additional monetary penalties and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.
- D. Checks and money orders shall be payable to the Kansas Corporation

 Commission. Payments shall be mailed to the Kansas Corporation Commission at 266 N. Main

 St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202. The payment must include a reference to the docket

 number of this proceeding. Credit card payments may be made by calling the Conservation

 Division at 316-337-6200.
- E. Any party may request a hearing on the above issues by submitting a written request, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-164, K.S.A. 77-537, and K.S.A. 77-542, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought, to the Commission at 266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within 30 days from the date of service of this Order. Hearings will be scheduled

only upon written request. <u>Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Operator's right to a hearing.</u>

F. If a party requests a hearing, a corporation or similar entity shall not be permitted to enter an appearance except by its attorney. K.A.R. 82-1-228(d). Attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record.

G. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.


