## PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Prehearing Officer finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On January 10, 2018, Quito, Inc. filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Arbuckle formation at the Royce #2 well located in the SE/4 of Section 18, Township 31 South, Range 13 East, Elk County, Kansas.
  - 2. On January 26, 2018, Russell and Deanna Jones filed a protest.
- 3. On February 15, 2018, the Commission issued an Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference setting the matter for a prehearing conference on March 2, 2018.
- 4. On March 1, 2018, Jeff Kennedy filed an Entry of Appearance on behalf of Quito, Inc.
- 5. On March 6, 2018, the Prehearing Officer issued a Prehearing Officer Order Setting Status Conference; Discovery and Protective Orders establishing an agreed upon procedural schedule.

6. On April 12, 2018, Staff of the State Corporation Commission (Staff) filed a Motion

to Modify Procedural Schedule regarding the Evidentiary Hearing date.<sup>1</sup>

7. On April 18, 2018, the Protestants filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest.

8. On May 9, 2018, Applicant filed a letter withdrawing its Application.

9. The Applicant has withdrawn the application and therefore there is no need for

further Commission action. Pursuant to the Prehearing Officer's delegation under K.S.A.

77-551(c) to handle procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b), the Prehearing Officer

finds the docket should be closed.

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. This Docket shall be closed.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
