#### **SUSPENSION ORDER: JUNE 23, 2017**

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On October 26, 2016, Westar Energy, Inc. and Kansas Gas and Electric Company (collectively, "Westar") filed an abbreviated rate case pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-231(b)(3)(A) and K.S.A. 66-117. Westar requested rates that would produce an additional \$17.4 million in annual revenues.
- 2. K.S.A. 66-117(c) states in part: "The commission shall not delay the effective date of the proposed change in rate, joint rate, toll, charge or classification or schedule of charges, or in any rule or regulation or practice pertaining to the service or rates of any such public utility or common carrier, more than 240 days beyond the date the public utility or common carrier filed its application requesting the proposed change. If the commission does not suspend the proposed schedule within 30 days of the date the same is filed by the public utility or common carrier, such proposed schedule shall be deemed approved by the commission and shall take effect on the proposed effective date."

3. A full investigation of the proposed rates, which may result in a hearing, is

deemed necessary and proper. Absent suspension, Commission Staff is without sufficient time

to fully review, consider, and analyze whether the proposed rates should be approved.

4. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of any potential

effectiveness of the rates and/or terms proposed by Westar is required to allow sufficient time for

full investigation of this matter. The effective date of the rates and/or terms proposed shall be

suspended for a period not to exceed 240 days from the date the Application was made, October

26, 2016, until Friday, June 23, 2017. A Commission decision may be issued before such date.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Any decision regarding Westar's proposed rate adjustments shall be deferred until

June 23, 2017. The Commission may issue a decision before such date.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by

mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration

of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
