ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER

1. On March 19, 2015, the Commission issued and mailed its Order Reducing Saltwater Injection Rates. The Order stated that any party may request a hearing within 30 days, with three days added to account for service by mail.

2. On April 17, 2015, SandRidge Exploration and Production, LLC ("SandRidge"),

filed its Motion to Intervene and Request for Hearing through counsel. The motion stated that

SandRidge was not sure whether the hearing request would be further pursued, but that the

request for hearing was being filed before the deadline to preserve the right if it is needed.

3. The Commission finds that SandRidge has demonstrated an interest in this proceeding pursuant to K.S.A. 77-521 and K.A.R. 82-1-225 and should be allowed to intervene.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-551(c), the Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer

should be designated in this proceeding to address any matters listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b).

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The motion by SandRidge to intervene in this docket is granted. Service of all pleadings in this docket shall be delivered to SandRidge's counsel.

B. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-521(c), the Commission may impose conditions upon the intervener's participation in the proceedings.

C. The request by SandRidge for a hearing is granted.

D. The Prehearing Officer in this proceeding shall be Lane R. Palmateer, Counsel, Kansas Corporation Commission, 266 N. Main, Ste. 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202, telephone number 316-337-6200, email address <u>l.palmateer@kcc.ks.gov</u>.

E. The Prehearing Officer may set this matter for a prehearing conference upon its own motion or on the motion of any party to this docket. Notice of any prehearing conference shall be mailed to the parties in this docket at least 14 calendar days before the scheduled date.
