I personally went down to your office on North Main Street in Wichita, KS. to renew my license, using one of your computers. I paid my \$1900.00 using your computer. I did all this before your deadlines. The payment went through & after a few weeks, my bank rejected the payment. I can only surmise that it was for security reasons, as safeguards must be in place since I was using your computer. I then wrote a check per KCC instructions to the KCC for \$1900.00. Check # 15 7219 for \$1900.00 written on Nov. 27, 2017. Check cleared my bank on Dec. 13, 2017. I was then contacted by State employee - Ms. Morgan. to make sure the check went to the appropriate parties.

Concerning 18-CONS-4117-CPEN numerous times. Your KOHAR system keeps rejecting it, for reasons unknown. I have spent considerable energies concerning this, including paying 2 fines. I have not received a reply concerning these rejected applications.

The docket concerns the Beltinger well in Butler County.

This is a new well that was drilled, completed, and produced on the Beltinger lands. I have no financial interest in said well. I surmise some KCC person did not personally like one of the principals in said well. His name is Ronnie Whitman. I was told by KCC person that the KCC would come down hard on me for helping Ronnie.
