ORDER ADOPTING COMPLIANCE REPORT AND CLOSING DOCKET

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, the Commission finds and concludes:

1. On August 1, 2024, the Commission directed Vantage Point Solutions (VPS) to perform an audit of Ring Central, Inc. (Ring) for Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) purposes.
2. On May 7, 2025, VPS filed its Audit Report making findings for Ring in Operating Year 27.¹ VPS recommended Ring take certain corrective actions to remedy issues discovered during the course of its audit.
3. The Commission issued an Order on May 13, 2025, adopting the recommendations of VPS and ordering the corrective actions be completed by June 12, 2025.
4. On June 12, 2025, Ring filed a Motion for Extension of Time.
5. The Commission issued an Order on June 24, 2025, granting an extension of time to August 11, 2025 for Ring to complete the recommended corrective actions.

6. On August 21, 2025, VPS issued a Compliance Report indicating Ring had complied with the Commission's Order issued May 13, 2025. VPS stated Ring had fulfilled all the requirements of the Order and followed Commission directives and recommended that the Docket be closed.

7. The Commission has reviewed the Audit Report filed by VPS in this matter and finds the recommendations to be reasonable and therefore concludes they should be adopted and this Docket should be closed.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The Commission accepts and adopts Vantage Point Solutions' Audit Report filed August 21, 2025, and hereby closes this Docket.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).²
