ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO SUBMIT DATA

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes:

- 1. On October 12, 2023, the Commission issued its Order Opening Docket; Protective Order Applicable to CURB; Requiring Entries of Appearance to Actively Participate; and Establishing Procedural Schedule (Opening Order) for the purposes of determining the annual assessment rate for the twenty-eighth year of the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF), effective March 1, 2024.
- 2. The Opening Order requires the Brightspeed Companies (Brightspeed) to provide Attachment A, intrastate access revenue and usage data, and supporting documentation by October 20, 2023.
- 3. On October 20, 2023, a Motion for Enlargement of Time to Submit Data and an Entry of Appearance were filed by Brightspeed.

4. Given the Brightspeed request for an enlargement of time and for good cause shown, the Brightspeed request for enlargement of time from October 20, 2023, to October 30, 2023, to comply with the Commission's Opening Order should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The motion for an enlargement of time is hereby granted and the time period for complying with the Opening Order's requirement for United Telephone Companies of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink a/k/a Brightspeed to file, in this Docket, its required Attachment A, its intrastate access revenue and usage data, and supporting documentation shall be by October 30, 2023. Failure to submit data in a timely manner may result in a penalty, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-138.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹
