ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION TO VACATE PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. JURISDICTION AND BACKGROUND

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,111, 66-1,112g and 66-1,115, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted in K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority, and jurisdiction.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130, and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke, or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision, or regulation of the Commission.

II. FINDINGS OF FACTS

3. Maghrebine Royalties Tr (Carrier) is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted in K.A.R. 82-4-3f, which operates commercial motor vehicles in interstate commerce under the USDOT Number 4162696.

4. On May 30, 2024, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket assessing a \$300 civil penalty against Carrier for failure to pay its 2024 UCR fees.

5. Carrier contacted Staff after the issuance of the Penalty Order stating that Carrier does not operate in interstate commerce and requested inactivation of its USDOT Number.

6. Staff inactivated the Carrier's USDOT Number. Additionally, after reviewing available records, Staff could not find evidence the carrier was found operating in interstate commerce. Staff therefore determined the Penalty Order issued for not paying their 2024 UCR fees should be vacated.

7. On June 13, 2024, Transportation Staff filed its Motion to Vacate Penalty Order recommending the Commission vacate the Penalty Order.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over Maghrebine Royalties Tr because Carrier is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted in K.A.R. 82-4-3f.

9. The Commission further finds that Carrier does not operate in interstate commerce.

10. Therefore the Commission concludes it is appropriate to vacate the Penalty Order issued May 30, 2024.

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

A. The Penalty Order issued to Maghrebine Royalties Tr on May 30, 2024 is hereby vacated.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹

BY THE COMMISSION IT IS SO ORDERED.
